

The village is also home to Edwalton Primary School, which is less than a mile from Edwalton Park, Jesse Gray Primary School and Ofsted Outstanding, West Bridgeford Infant, and West Bridgford Junior School, are among the best for younger children. Older children can attend The Beckett School or Ofsted Outstanding Rushcliffe School and The West Bridgford School. For Higher education, the University of Nottingham and Nottingham Trent University are a great choice.

Edwalton Park is well connected for commuting for work, everyday trips to school or the shops, outings to Nottingham, or further afield. By car, the A606 Melton Road runs directly from your doorstep into Nottingham city centre, while the M1 and other main routes including the A60, A46 and A52 are all nearby, making travelling to Leicester, Derby, and Lincoln, easy. There are a number of bus services that make the same journeys, as well as a tram service throughout the city and local area.

Nottingham Train Station (3.7 miles away), offers regular services throughout the West Midlands, including Birmingham (New Street 1hr 14mins), Leeds (1hr 14mins), Manchester (Oxford Road 1hr 53mins), as well as London (St Pancras, 1hr 42mins). Nottingham itself is on hand for everyday amenities, leisure attractions and things to see and do.









For shopping, you'll find intu Victoria Centre, Broadmarsh Shopping Centre, the boutique shopping experience of Flying Horse Walk and the Exchange Arcade. All located in the centre of Nottingham's retail heart there are shops and stores for all, as well as an ample choice of cafes, bars and restaurants to suit all tastes.

Explore the city's historical attractions including Nottingham Castle, City of Caves and the enchanting Sherwood Forest. Or then why not enjoy the exciting arts and cultural events that take place throughout the year, from live music performances to some exciting food and drink festivals.
