Nestled in the shadows of the Chiltern Hills, Redkite View in Watlington is perfectly situated within a rural market town steeped with history, whilst still being close enough to larger town amenities.

Watlington is perfectly picturesque with origins dating back to the 6th century. The dominating 17th century town hall is accompanied by 16th century and Georgian buildings and as you stroll through the town you'll be charmed by its history, character and countryside setting. There is also an assortment of independent retailers selling a selection of goods, services and hospitality, making it the embodiment of a small English market town.

If you are looking for some breathtaking scenery then the Chiltern Hills, one of South East England's most beautiful landscapes, rises above the town and makes the perfect backdrop for outdoor enthusiasts.





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You can walk for hours and get lost in its nature, with the surrounding area of Watlington being known for Red Kites soaring in the skies above. These distinctive birds of prey were re-introduced to the Chilterns from Spain in 1989-1994, as they had become extinct in England by the end of the 19th century, with just a few breeding pairs existing in Wales.

Even with its rural setting, Watlington has connections to Thames Travel services to Reading, Oxford, Didcot and Henley. The nearest railway station is Princes Risborough operated by Chiltern Railways. Regular services operate to London, meaning you can be there in under an hour and Oxford in just under 35 minutes.
