



Primary schools, all of which are between half a mile and two miles from Keyworth Rise, include Keyworth Primary & Nursery, Crossdale Primary, Willow Brook Primary, Bunny Cof E Primary and Tollerton Primary, rated Ofsted 'Outstanding'. For older children, secondary schools include South Wolds Academy and Ofsted rated 'Outstanding' schools, Rushcliffe Spencer Academy and The West Bridgford School.

For those considering further education, the Midlands around Keyworth provides a wide choice of institutions and subjects, including universities in Nottingham, Leicester, Birmingham, Loughborough, Coventry and Warwick, to name just a few.

Keyworth is surrounded by open countryside and farmland, with plenty of footpaths to safely enjoy, whether on foot or cycle. With many architectural findings going back as far as Roman times, there are also many historic villages to explore close by.

If you prefer to spend your leisure time in a less leisurely fashion, the dynamic city of Nottingham is just six miles away. Here's where you'll find an unrivalled range of high street brands, chic boutiques and independent retailers alongside an equally impressive selection of bars, bistros, cafes and restaurants.

What's more, fans of cinema, theatre, history, art and live sports events and concerts are also spoilt for choice in the city. Whether you need to travel for business or pleasure, the daily commute or weekend shopping, Keyworth Rise offers all the right transport connections to make light of your journey.

There are excellent road links to Nottingham via the A52, Leicester via the A46 and Loughborough via A60, putting all three centres within 30 minutes of the development, which is ideal for commuters.

The nations motorway network is also easily accessible from the M1 (via A52), which is around 12 miles away from Keyworth Rise.

If you prefer to let the train take the strain, Nottingham Train Station is 8 miles or approximately a 20 minute drive. From there you can choose from regular services to London, Birmingham New Street, Coventry and Peterborough.

And if your travels take you further afield, East Midlands Airport is around 14 miles away by road and provides services to over 90 destinations around the world.

Last but far from least, Nottingham has its own tram system, the Nottingham Express Transit (NET). At 32 kilometres long this makes for fast, easy and cost effective movement around town with the nearest stop being just over 5 miles from Keyworth Rise.
