We always go that extra mile to ensure we build in locations close to good schools, amenities and transport links, and Hollycroft Grange is certainly no exception.

Families moving to Hollycroft Grange will appreciate the wide choice of excellent schools for all ages, in the surrounding area. Around 0.6 miles from Hollycroft Grange is Little Battlers Pre-School rated 'Good' by Ofsted. For older children, the 'Good' Battling Brook Primary School is 15 minutes walking distance of home, while Westfield Infant (Ofsted Rating – 'Outstanding') & Junior School (rated 'Good') and Richmond Primary School (rated 'Good') are Both 1.4 miles away respectively.

Older students have the option of independent and state secondary schools. Independent schools include Redmoor Academy, 2.7 miles away, with Hastings - rated 'Good' less than 3 miles away. A little further away is the 'Outstanding' Independent school

– The Dixie Grammar School for Nursery, Junior and Senior pupils through to Sixth Form (5.7 miles). For higher education, you have the choice of De Montfort University and University of Leicester which are both approximately 11 miles away.

Hinckley is a growing Market Town with a good choice of amenities. Just a short distance from home you will find a convenience store, a doctors' surgery, a small range of independent businesses, post office and a Stoke Golding village hall. A little further away, at just over a mile, is Hollycroft Park. As well as being a large outdoor space, you'll find a Tennis Court area, Bowling Green, Pitch and Putt Area, an art deco style bandstand, a bowls pavilion and toilets.

For a wider range of shops, culture and entertainment options, visit Hinckley's Town Centre, only 1.2 miles away. Here you'll find everything from your high street brands to independent names and places to eat and drink at The Crescent or The Britannia Centre. And if you want to pick up fresh produce, the bustling Hinckley Market every Monday, Friday and Saturday.

Beyond the shops, restaurants, bars and coffee shops, Hinckley has plenty more to offer. Entertainment options include cinemas, theatres and various leisure centres. Or if you really want to just be in the open air, there are a number of parks and open spaces to relax in including a golf course for that budding Tiger Woods.

Alongside all of this, Hinckley and its surrounding villages have great places where you can discover a great deal of history. There are museums dedicated to transport and Industry, or then for a great family day out visit Bosworth

Heritage Centre, which is steeped in history dating back to the Battle of Bosworth in 1485 – The Battlefield covers a wide area of farmland, which has a network of public rights of way. They also promote guided walks, fairs, workshops and exhibitions to suit all ages.

If you are looking at something different then you can always take The Triumph Factory Tour, this is the perfect experience if you've ever wanted to venture beyond those legendary factory doors, they offer a fully guided tour which really does take you from concept to manufacturing and final assembly to see for yourselves where world-renowned Triumph motorcycles are created and built.

Keeping fit is simple in Hinckley. There are several gyms and fitness clubs to choose from. But if you want to enjoy a round or two of golf, you will have a number of courses to visit, including Hinckley Golf Course, just over 3 miles away.
