Summerfield Nurseries will bring to life a truly enchanting new community in a highly desirable location just outside the village of Staple in Kent, 9 miles east of the historic cathedral city of Canterbury.

Staple parish comprises the village itself, the hamlet of Barnsole, part of the hamlet of Summerfield and the hamlet of Shatterling. Nearby are the beautiful villages Wingham and Ash, which have a wide range of local conveniences.









A Community Feel

Staple Parish may be small in size but offers several local clubs, societies, and interest groups.

The Black Pig, located on Barnsole Road, which is an absolute must for those seeking a quintessential English Pub with its oak beams, beer garden, and guest rooms.

Nearby on Flemming Road, Staple, you will find the award-winning Barnsole Vineyard, which offers a selection of English wines produced from grapes grown on the verdant flats of Barnsole; the Vineyard also offers tasting tours.

The annual Staple Country-Fayre is held to bring together the entire parish with many things for the whole family to do, including the Dog Show, fetes and Open Garden Events, to name a few.







Everything on your doorstep

Summerfield Nurseries sits only 9 miles from the cathedral city of Canterbury, home to top high street brands, restaurants, coffee shops and supermarkets.

For education, there is the University of Kent, Canterbury Christ Church University and the University for the Creative Arts. There are also many other independent and state primary and secondary schooling options, including the 'Outstanding' rated St. Thomas' Catholic Primary School, Barton Court Grammar School and The King's School.

Many other places of interest are within a 5-mile radius, ideal for cycling or walking among Outstanding Areas of Natural Beauty. The famous Kent coast and seaside towns of Whitstable, Herne Bay and Sandwich Bay are just a 25-minute drive away.







Sporting & Leisure

Ideal for sports enthusiasts, world-class recreational facilities are on your doorstep at Summerfield Nurseries, with local sports clubs galore and the Wingham Sports Pavilion only a short drive away.

Nearby, an idyllic 18-hole woodland course at the Canterbury Golf Club is part of the Kent landscape, which travels through unspoilt valleys, hills and forest. For golf by the sea, Royal St. Georges Golf Club is located under 6 miles away in the medieval town of Sandwich and offers a test for even the experienced player. Also close by is St. Lawrence Cricket Ground, home of the ICC and Polo Farm Sports Club.

The area offers various leisure opportunities for all the family, including nature walks and animal attractions such as Wingham Wildlife Park.

In nearby Canterbury, there are a series of annual events, including the Canterbury International Arts Festival in September, as well as festivals of family-friendly entertainment at Herne Bay.



Travel



For commuters wishing to travel to London by train, Canterbury West serves London St. Pancras in less than an hour, whilst Canterbury East and West stations also have trains to London Victoria and Charing Cross in approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.

The A2 and M2 are conveniently close by for travel by car, connecting to the M25 and more comprehensive motorway network.

For continental commuters, the Channel ports and tunnel are no more than 30 minutes away.

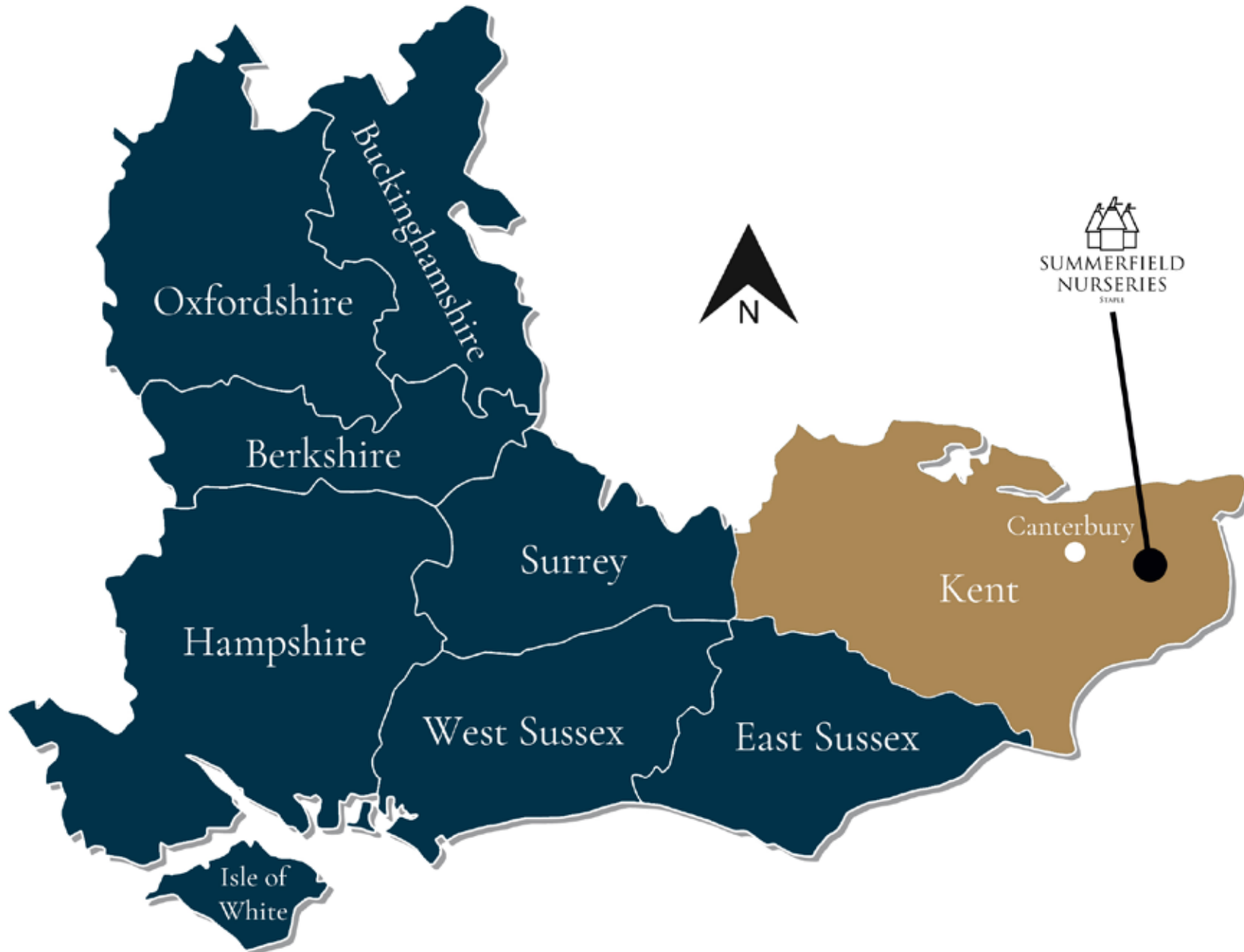
