



A platform for Tottenham's uniquely diverse talent, the arts centre was Designed by Sir David Adjaye. The purposebuilt complex opened in 2007 and comprises a 274-seat theatre, multi-purpose studio spaces, boutique cinema, 20 enterprise units, and an award-winning Café & Bar. It's here that Tottenham's talent is nurtured - from visual media and the performing arts to fashion and design.

This creativity is the lifeblood of today's Tottenham, a vibrant and proudly individual neighbourhood where alternative music spaces, and cutting edge galleries are making it one of London's most fashionable new postcodes. It's also a place that can revive as well as inspire with its tranquil waterways and wildlife abundant marshland.

On the streets around Hale Village are a host of interesting spots that will soon have you feeling like a local. Founded by hairdresser turned barista Matt Ho and his partner, live music promoter Rachel, Craving is known for its Tottenham Social food pop ups and art exhibitions.

One of London's best-known craft ale brewers with a taproom on your doorstep, Beavertown have recently set up a microbrewery at Tottenham Hotspur. It makes a visit to this state of the art stadium even more essential. The main Beavertown brewery is found next door to Hale Village where the taproom is open to the public on Saturdays

from fishing to bird watching. It's also home to the Engine House Café, located in a 19th Century listed building. It's operated by the people behind The Larder café known for their healthy brunches. Or try one of the Eco-Hampers for a bespoke riverside picnic.





SHOREDITCH STRATFORD KINGS CROSS HACKNEY

WHERE EAST LONDON'S CREATIVE RENAISSANCE BEGAN, SHOREDITCH IS AN EVER-CHANGING BASE OF LONDON'S COOLEST QUARTERS.

Here curated fashion and lifestyle stores like Goodhood sit alongside renowned eateries such as Merchants Tavern and hidden cocktail bars like the atmospheric speakeasy Nightjar.

Head to Redchurch Street for boutiques like APC and retro homeware store Labour & Wait. Pop into Boundary for that Lower East Side style brunch before making your way to the famous vintage shops and galleries of Brick Lane.

East London at its most wildly inventive, Hackney is an ever-evolving area that you will never tire of exploring. With organic food stalls, quirky cafés and vintage curios Broadway Market is the perfect place to start. For a more cutting edge East London experience head

to Hackney Wick, home to experimental galleries in old industrial units like Stour Gallery and canal-side spots such as CRATE, a pizzeria with its own brewery.

Once an industrial wasteland, King's Cross is now one of London's most rewarding destinations. Within the old converted Victorian brick viaducts of Coal Drops Yard you will find some of the capital's most stylish stores like Margaret Howell and Universal Works, together with acclaimed restaurants such as Barrafina and Casa & Plaza Pastor. Other well-known names can also be found at Westfield in Stratford that brings you the best of the West End.

From a quick commute by train into the City to a leisurely bike ride to pick up your weekend provisions, you are perfectly placed to make the best of London.

A short walk from Hale Works is Tottenham Hale station where Victoria line underground trains take you into the King's Cross Eurostar connections in 10 minutes or Oxford Street for Soho in 16 mins. Regular overground

trains travel into Stratford in 10 mins and Liverpool Street in 15 mins. Or choose to commute to Liverpool Street by bike in just over half an hour.

For weekend ventures and spontaneous nights out, you can take the overground from Highbury & Islington (8 mins on Victoria Line) bringing you to Dalston Kingsland in 5 minutes and Shoreditch High Street in




GETTING AROUND

You can also choose to explore East London's many creative corners by bike with Stoke Newington just 15 minutes away and Hoxton half an hour. Alternatively, pick up the towpath at Ferry Lane and follow the River Lee canal past Walthamstow Marshes all the way to Victoria Park.

And with the reservoirs and grasslands of Walthamstow Wetlands just 10 minutes away, the area is also great for walking when you want a breath of fresh air.









KITCHEN








BEDROOMS

Parking

 Hale Works is a car-free development. Purchasers will not be able to apply for a residents parking permit from the London Borough of Haringey.



SHARED OWNERSHIP

You can buy an initial share of between 25% - 75% of the property's value, and pay a subsidised rent on the proportion you don't yet own. You can choose to increase the share you have in your home as your income increases, until you own 100% of the property. This scheme makes getting onto the property ladder affordable and flexible, as the split between owned/rented is based on how much you can afford to pay.

CAN I APPLY?

Most people who do not own a property are eligible to apply for Shared Ownership with Newlon Living. To qualify you should fall into the following categories:

You must be a first time buyer who cannot afford to buy a suitable home on the open market.

You should have access to savings to cover the cost of the mortgage deposit, mortgage valuation or survey, legal fees and stamp duty (where applicable).

Priority will go to people who live or work in the London Borough of Haringey.

Gross household income must not exceed £90,000 per annum.
