Situated in an elevated position, behind secure entry timber gates, 1 Westgate Barn sits serenely within its plot, overlooking stunning, open field views to its front aspect, to be admired from the kitchen sink as the seasons change.











The property is beautifully presented and space has been considered throughout. The reception hall is both light and airy, made cosy in the evenings by closing the stunning plantation shutters.

Informal dining and sitting around the island in the split level kitchen, makes for the chefs to be entertained by their guests, whilst preparing their delights.

There is a relaxed atmosphere in this home, albeit more formal dining can be achieved in the charming dining room, with its hand-painted, artisanal wallpaper and bespoke bookcase.





The flexibility of the property comes into its own, with a study/bedroom four on the ground floor, which includes independent access to the garden.





The garden and grounds have been meticulously designed for ease of maintenance and incorporate a sweeping gravel drive, with ample parking, leading to the double detached garage.


There is a wonderful sense of community within the village, which our vendors have enjoyed alongside all of its amenities.



IN NORFOLK
IS THE PLACE TO CALL HOME







Binham is a typical Norfolk village, ideal as a base for exploring the north Norfolk Coast. It has the magnificent late 11th century Benedictine

Priory, which was one of the first religious institutions established in Norfolk.

Partially ruined by Henry VIII during the Reformation, the Priory is among the most complete and impressive ruins in Norfolk.

The nave of the church, with its beautiful 13th century west front, was repaired and is now the parish church. The site is thought to have its own ghost, The Black-Hooded Monk.

With a large playing field, including a football pitch and a children's play area with climbing frames, swings and a zip wire, Binham Village Memorial Hall is located in the heart of the village and is available to hire for private functions.

Binham is home to many charming brick and flint cottages, Howells Super Store corner shop, a cosy pub, The Chequers Inn, and The Parlour café and tea room, which is next door to The Little Dairy Shop, an ever-popular 'self-service' farm shop.

Just over five miles away is Wells-next-the-Sea, with its sandy beach and pretty candy-striped huts, it's easy to understand why this sleepy coastal town is a haven for day trippers and holiday makers. There are plenty of ways to explore the waterways that surround the area. For a nautical adventure, jump aboard one of the Coastal Exploration Company's traditional wooden sailing boats and adventure hidden creeks, marshes and open sea. Or test your balance with a standup paddleboarding session with Barefoot SUP. With a bustling community, the town is well-serviced with a primary and secondary schools, plus a GP surgery and library.
