The Property

Rose Cottage is a very pretty stone cottage situated in a peaceful lane on the outskirts of Hedley on the Hill.

Climbing plants around the front door make for an attractive entrance into the porch, which opens into the sitting room with its bow window, beamed ceiling, character stone fireplace with open fire and carved wooden staircase to the first floor. Off the sitting room is another good-sized room with built-in cupboard, currently used as the principle bedroom, but that could easily be set out as another reception room. A wooden loft ladder provides access to attic storage.

To the other side of the sitting room a door leads through into rear corridor, from which the dining room, kitchen and bathroom are accessed. Like the sitting room, each of these rooms to the rear have exposed wooden beams and features, and lovely views from traditional-style leaded windows across the leafy garden. This garden can be accessed from the kitchen via French doors onto a decked area. The bathroom features a wonderful free-standing roll-top bath, so in keeping with the style of the property, with a shower head attachment for convenience. Beside the bathroom a rear porch leads out onto the patio.

The current owners have developed plans for the decked area to be converted into a conservatory, creating wonderful additional living accommodation overlooking the rear garden.

Up the impressive wooden staircase is a delightful bedroom in the eaves with light flooding in from the dual windows and further access to the attic storage.





















Externally

To the front of Rose Cottage is parking on the paved drive for several cars and a secluded lawn with the summerhouse tucked away. Access through a side gate leads to a patio area, the workshop with electricity and a decked seating area. Mature trees and bushes provide a feeling of privacy.

Local Information

Hedley on the Hill is a popular village on the borders of Northumberland, County Durham and Tyne and Wear which sits amidst stunning countryside yet is well-positioned for access to local amenities and regional centres. For the outdoor enthusiasts there are excellent woodland walks and cycling nearby whilst Matfen Hall, Slaley Hall and Close House offer excellent leisure facilities including spa, gym, golf courses and driving range and Hexham Racecourse is also nearby. Hedley on the Hill has a renowned country pub, The Feathers Inn, and nearby Stocksfield offers excellent local amenities including a thriving golf club, shops, post office, doctor's surgery, petrol station and Cricket Club. Further facilities are available in Newcastle which provides comprehensive shopping, professional and entertainment opportunities.

For schooling, there are primary schools in Stocksfield and nearby Mickley while senior schooling is available in Hexham and Prudhoe. In addition, Mowden Hall Preparatory School just outside Corbridge provides private education from nursery up to 13 years, and there are several private day schools in Newcastle.


For the commuter, there are excellent road links to Newcastle and other regional centres and Newcastle International Airport, Newcastle Rail Stations and the A1 are all extremely accessible. The rail station in Stocksfield provides excellent cross-country services east and west to Newcastle and Carlisle, which in turn link to other main line services to major UK cities north and south.

From Stocksfield leave the A695 at Branch End and follow New Ridley Road for 1.2 miles. Take the left turning signposted to Hedley on the Hill and continue on this road to Hedley on the Hill. On passing the stone village signs for Hedley on the Hill, continue for 0.3 miles, go past The Feathers Inn on the right and then turn left onto High View.

Bear right onto Meadows Crest and the driveway into Rose Cottage is the second on the left.
