Externally, the property enjoys off road parking for two vehicles within a car port and a south facing rear garden





With composite and obscure glazed front door opening into:

Entrance Hall

With stairs rising to first floor landing, smoke alarm, ceiling lighting, power points, wood effect LVT flooring with underfloor heating and doors to rooms.

Cloakroom

Comprising a low level WC with integrated flush, wall mounted wash hand basin with mixer tap and tiled splashback, insert ceiling downlighting, extractor fan, wood effect LVT flooring with underfloor heating.

Open Plan Living Area - 25'11" max x 19'4" max

Kitchen

Comprising an array of eye and base level cupboards and drawers with complimentary stone worksurface, one and a half bowl under sunk composite sink unit with mixer tap over, Neff 4 ring induction hob with splashback and extractor fan above, Neff oven, integrated fridge-freezer, integrated dishwasher, integrated washing machine, insert ceiling downlighting, under counter display lighting, window to front overlooking countryside views, smoke alarm, power points, wood effect LVT flooring with underfloor heating and continuing into:

Living Area

With bi-folding doors opening onto south facing rear garden, ceiling lighting, smoke alarm, array of TV and power points, understairs cupboard housing fuse board and underfloor heating manifold, window to rear.

First Floor Landing

With access to loft, ceiling lighting, smoke alarm, fitted carpet, power points, airing cupboard housing Vaillant boiler and doors to rooms.

Bedroom 1 - 12'11" x 11'2"

With window overlooking countryside views, ceiling lighting, fitted carpet, wall mounted radiator, TV and power points, door into:

Dressing Area - 10'2" x 9'8"

With window to rear, ceiling lighting, wall mounted radiator, fitted carpet and door to:

En-suite - 9'8" x 8'5"

Comprising a 4 piece suite of panel enclosed bath and mixer tap, low level WC with integrated flush, wall mounted wash hand basin with mixer tap and tiled splashback, fully tiled and glazed shower cubicle, window to front overlooking rear garden, insert ceiling downlighting, chromium heated towel rail, tiled flooring, electric shaving point, extractor fan.

Bedroom 2 - 12'7" x 11'2"

With two windows overlooking countryside views, ceiling lighting, wall mounted radiator, TV and power points, fitted carpet.

Bedroom 3 - 9'1" x 7'11"

With window overlooking rear garden, ceiling lighting, wall mounted radiator, TV and power points, fitted carpet.

Family Bathroom - 7'11" x 6'7"

Comprising a panel enclosed bah with mixer tap and full tiled surround, panel and glazed shower screen with shower attachment, low level WC with integrated flush, wall mounted wash hand basin with mixer tap and tiled splashback, fully tiled and glazed shower cubicle, window to front overlooking countryside views, insert ceiling downlighting, chromium heated towel rail, tiled flooring, electric shaving point.

The front of the property is approached by a paved pathway leading to storm porch with outside lighting, front lawn, external water point, block paved driveway and car port supplying off-street parking for 2 vehicles, personnel gate leading to:


South Facing Rear Garden


