The Barbican Estate is the finest achievement of the architects Chamberlin, Powell & Bon. It was Grade II listed in 2001 in recognition of its extraordinary contribution to London's urban landscape. Barbican tube station (on the Cirde, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan lines) is only a couple of minutes' walk away, with Moorgate (on the Northern line), St Paul's (on the Central line) and Mansion House (on the District line) tube stations each within a short walking distance. The new Elizabeth Line Farringdon Station is the busiest station interchange in London. Direct access to Canary Wharf in 9 minutes & Bond Street in 3 minutes. Waitrose, Marks & Spencer and Tesco are also nearby, together with various local services and amenities (such as dry cleaners, ironmongers, builders and plumbing merchants) and the numerous bars and restaurants of Clerkenwell and the City. Also within easy reach are the attractions of St. Pauls' Cathedral, The River, South Bank, Tate Modern, Gabriel's Wharf, numerous Bars, Restaurants', Café's Bank Of England, the 250,000 Sq. Ft , New Change Shopping Complex.

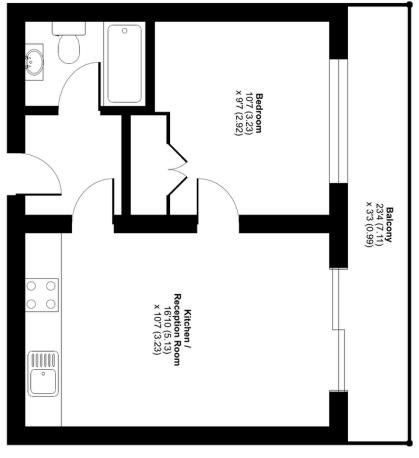
