The cottage is available unfurnished with all white goods. The property has oil fired central heating and a private courtyard garden whilst there is use of a larger garden if required.

Situation


This fully self-contained cottage is rurally located at Eastcourt and forms part of a wing of a larger farmhouse. The cottage is in the middle of the small, quiet village of Eastcourt, about five minutes from Crudwell and four minutes from Oaksey, with its excellent village shop, Post Office and popular pub. The surrounding countryside is completely unspoilt, on the edge of the Wiltshire / Gloucestershire border, close to Kemble station (eight minutes), Cirencester (fifteen minutes), and Malmesbury (ten minutes).

Directions

From Malmesbury head north towards Cirencester on the A429. After 2 miles enter Crudwell, continue through the village and take the first right signed for Eastcourt and Oaksey opposite the Potting Shed pub. Continue through the lanes for about a mile and on entering Eastcourt, after one house on right, turn right into the second of two adjoining driveways marked Granary and Barley Cottage.
