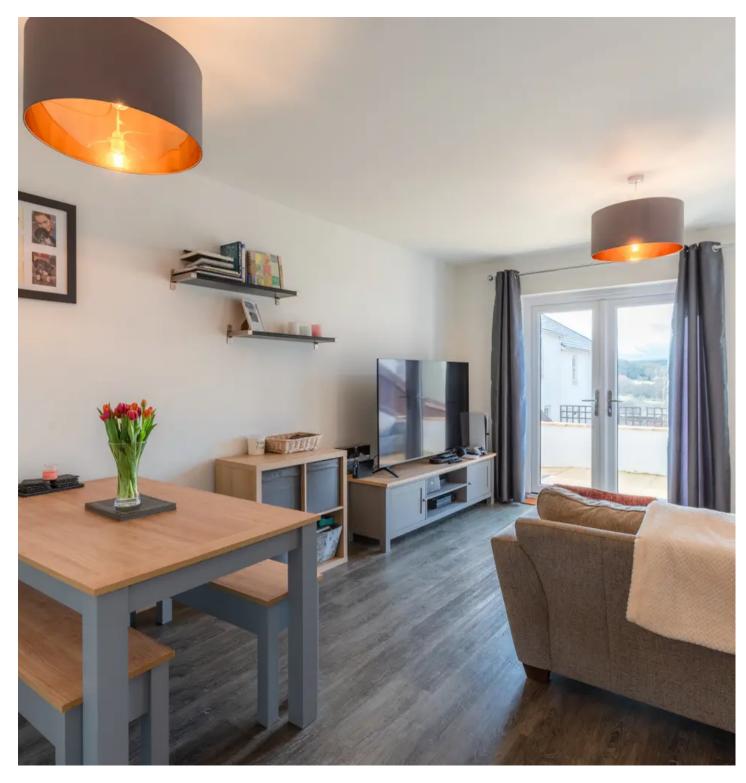

The Tarka View development of new freehold homes in Crediton has been built by the well-regarded Devonshire Homes, with the first properties being completed in 2018 and the final phase due to finished very shortly. It is ideally positioned on the Exeter (SE) side of the town with excellent transport on road and rail into Exeter centre, found just 7 miles away. This house is the Tavy Style and the current owner was the 1st to move in, back in 2018.







It packs a high level of style into a well-designed home - the hallway gives access to the cloakroom with WC, stairs, kitchen with integrated oven, hob and extractor and a lounge diner with double doors to the garden and views beyond.

Upstairs there are two double bedrooms and a modern bathroom which has a shower and screen over the bath. As you would expect there is uPVC double glazing and mains gas central heating throughout, with Hive smart controls and filtered air ventilation system.

The reason the current owners opted for this plot was its south-facing rear garden enjoying the views immediately outside the double doors. Off-road parking is provided to the front too.

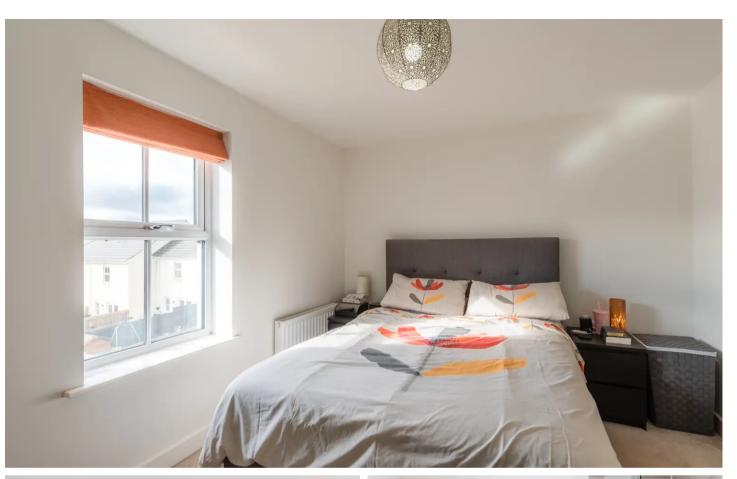

All neatly held in a single valley.

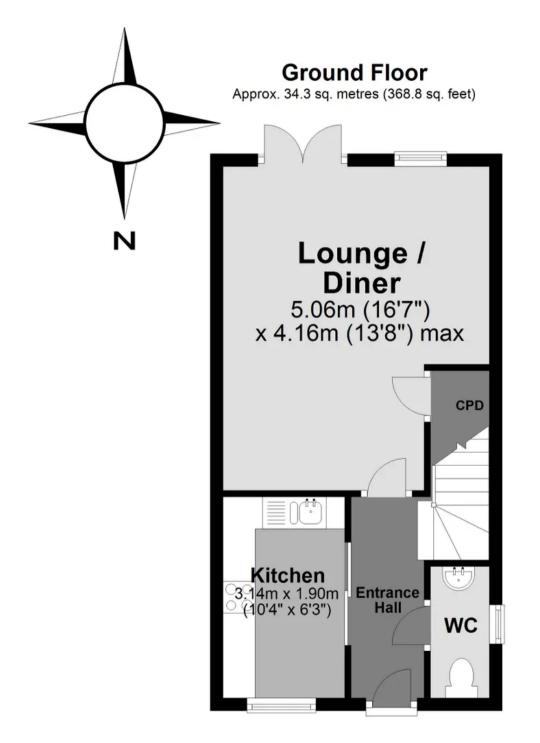
From Exeter: Head towards Crediton and once reaching the roundabout by the Crediton Tesco superstore, take the third exit and then first left into Tarka View.

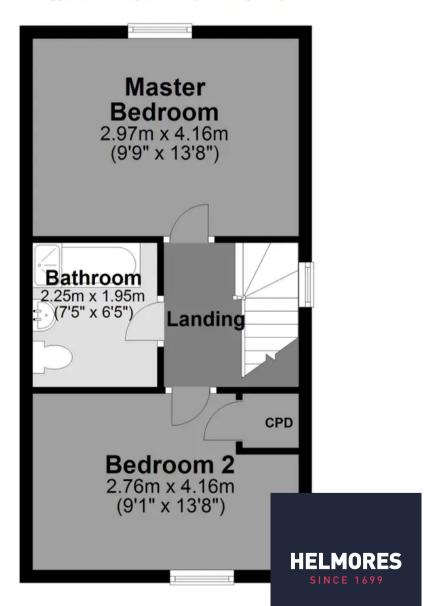






## **First Floor**
