Bright and spacious, lateral living space, spanning over 1,350 sq.ft., commanding a prime residential location in the historic Georgian market town of Holt.

Well-maintained throughout, '5 Pearsons Close' is a fine example of a detached bungalow, enjoying easy access to the thriving town centre, yet blessed with a particularly quiet and discreet residential setting. Offering a high degree of versatility and plenty of potential for further enhancement this superb, single-

story home has so much to offer and the coastline is just a short drive away.

A front porch provides ample boot and cloaks space and leads through to a central hall. The open-plan sitting room and dining area spans over 23' in length to create a spacious and sociable main living space. This impressive room features a bay window to a southerly aspect, a fireplace with wood-burner, and double french doors onto a predominantly glazed sun lounge.









An L-shaped kitchen/dining room enjoys a triple aspect and is fitted with a comprehensive range of wall and base units, a breakfast bar and dining/breakfast area. Off the kitchen is a utility room and access to the rear garden.

Set away from the living area is the bedroom wing, which comprises of three double bedrooms, with the principal bedroom featuring an attractive bay window with a southerly aspect. The bedrooms are perfectly served by a modern, family sized bathroom.









The property is blessed with mature and established gardens, which provide a delightful and private environment. The front garden enjoys a high degree of privacy and a sunny southerly aspect with lawns, shrub/flowering borders and a mature front boundary. The driveway provides ample off road parking and leads to the attached garage.


