

Sports facilities in the area include football, rugby and cricket clubs along with water activities being offered on the river. Melksham also has great provision for other clubs including dance, gymnastics and martial arts. Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Rainbows, Brownies and Guides also have groups in the town. The towns of Calne, Corsham, Trowbridge and Chippenham are a short distance away, with Chippenham having mainline rail services into London in







