

Fosse Cottage

A well-presented modern two-bedroom Cotswold stone semi-detached home in a tucked away in a cul-de-sac location on the edge of Lower Slaughter.

Upon entering the property, to the left hand side is a lovely sitting room with a gas fire place as the main focal point of the room. To the end of the hall is a large kitchen/breakfast room overlooking the enclosed rear garden.

Downstairs, there is also a cloakroom/WC.

Upstairs, the master bedroom is spacious fitting a king-size bed, the second bedroom is also a good-sized double. The tiled bathroom has a shower over bath, with basin and WC.

The easterly facing garden is enclosed and laid to grass with shrub boarders and a seating area perfect for al fresco dining. There is two car ports for parking.


