
## Broadclose, Western Road

Situated on the Western side of Crediton with level access to the High Street, this substantial semidetached house is spread over 3 floors and offers very spacious accommodation for a house in this price range.







The ground floor enjoys great a sized living room and a study/garden room off the large dining room, plus a half staircase then leading to the kitchen which has access to the rear and cloakroom with WC. The first floor has three bedrooms, a white suite family bathroom with P-shaped bath and shower over, plus a staircase leading to the master bedroom which has been created in the loft space with its own dressing/study area & built-in wardrobes. The property benefits from mains gas central heating and uPVC double glazing.

To the rear is the enclosed garden which is largely laid to lawn, plus an area of decked seating area immediately outside the study/garden room and an off-road parking space to the side.

Agents' note: For viewings, it's best to park on the opposite side of the road or in Broadclose.


