The Chandos, a former public house is an exceptional 17<sup>th</sup> Century property which has been the subject of a major restoration by the current owners who have brought it back to life reflecting the original features, creating a home of elegance and charm.

The impressive reception hall boasts a log burner and leads to a comfortable sitting room with a working open fireplace and exposed beams. There is an inner hallway which leads to a stylishly presented kitchen diner which is very much the heart of the house and includes a range of fitted units with wooden worktops and a door leading out to the rear garden.

Stairs leading to a spacious landing providing access to the generously proportioned principal bedroom with fitted wardrobes and an en suite shower WC and there are three further good sized bedrooms on this floor.

Outside, the rear garden has three seating patio areas, mature trees, shrubs and a lawn. The views of undulating countryside are absolutely stunning. There is a useful workshop and a garage; both with power and there is off street parking for several vehicles.
