














o the first floor, there is a delightful I en-suite principal bedroom with en-suite, a further bedroom and family bathroom.

A bedroom to the second floor completes the accommodation and commands delightful, elevated views.





















Loffering plenty of space for the whole family to enjoy, and forms an ideal base to explore Cley and the further Norfolk coastline, with ample parking just a few yards away.

Cley-next-the-Sea, a feature that this small coastal village is famous for alongside it's wonderful beach. The village has unique shops, two pubs, a church and two of the best food shops in England - The Cley Smoke House, for fabulous smoked fish and Picnic Fayre, a real delicatessen for the serious foodie.

Less than five miles away, a strong sense of community thrives among the proud residents and local businesses of Holt. Throughout the year, there are plenty of local events including a summer Holt Festival and 1940s Weekend, which takes over the town and 'Poppy Line' heritage railway that runs between here and Sheringham.

With a traditional butcher, fishmonger and greengrocer, the town even has its own department store and food hall, Bakers and Larners, a local landmark which has been run by the same family since 1770. On the edge of town is the historic Gresham's School, founded in 1955.

The town and its surrounding yards house a collection of chic boutiques and luxe lifestyle stores to explore and fill your home and wardrobe with beautiful things – linger and choose your favourite locally made fragrance at Norfolk Natural Living.
