

The Land

Extending to just over **7 acres (2.84ha)** in area, the land is accessed directly off a council road and is a safe haven well away from passing traffic, being designated an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB). The land comprises three fields with a gentle northeasterly aspect and will appeal to a wide range of purchasers but especially those in the immediate locality needing land for grazing animals, horticulture, conservation or some other amenity use. The natural pond is a delightful feature.

Of particular note are the Cornish hedges enclosing and dividing the meadows featuring several spreading oaks as well as a proliferation of sycamore and beech trees. All three fields are laid to grass and to one side of the gate is a very useful pole barn.



Services: Mains water is not connected to the land.

Wayleaves, Easements & Rights of Way: The sale will be subject to and with the benefit of all existing wayleaves, easements and rights of way as may exist.

Basic Farm Payment: There are no entitlements to the Basic Payment included with the land.

Turn right here and then next left signposted Carwen. Continue onto the moor for 350 yards after the cattle grid, and the gateway to the subject land will be found on the righthand side. **what3words**///tower.areas.brisk
