On the eastern edge of the town and with footpaths to countryside walks just seconds away, the Willow Walk area of town has been a family destination for years. It's a safe and friendly area with easy links to the town, schools and supermarkets plus the leisure centre and miles of walks are right on the doorstep. The houses on Exhibition Road have good sized front gardens which set them back from the road and then access to the parking and garages is in behind.

This property has undergone a full renovation in the past 2/3 years and now gives a new owner the opportunity to move into a "show home", knowing that as well as the superficial finishes, work has been done behind the scenes too. Rewiring, a new boiler, new kitchen and bathroom, new carpets, reskimmed, new windows, loft insulation and boarding, it really is ready to enjoy.







The front hall opens into the living room with a media wall and built in shelving and cupboards making the most of the space available and with a feature electric fireplace. There's an understairs cupboard too. The kitchen is a great size with plenty of storage space and two ovens, ideal for those big family meals. Beyond the kitchen is a conservatory which is used as a second sitting room and a dining area. There's a very clever hidden utilities space and room for coats and shoes behind full height sliding doors. On the first floor, there's a double room, a single room and the original main bedroom has been split into either 2 bedrooms (one is a through room) or a bedroom and study area. It's worth noting that this could easily be reverted back to one larger bedroom but it currently allows for a 4th occasional bedroom or ideal for 2 younger children to use these 2 rooms. The bathroom has also been refitted with a white suite.

Outside, to the front, there's a long front garden, mainly lawned with steps down and a lower patio/pond area. At the back is a fenced off garden of approx. 5m x 5m and it is south east facing so enjoys the sun a the rear. There's a driveway (concrete drive 3rd from right) which provides parking for 3 vehicles and leads to the single garage.
