The town has a new leisure centre with swimming pool, fitness centre and library. There are a range of shops, cafes, restaurants and supermarkets. Cranesbill Play Area is a short distance away. There are a range of primary schools in the area including Forest and Sandridge (rated good), River Mead (rated good) and Aloeric (rated good) all within 1 mile of the house. Melksham Oak Secondary school (rated good) is also a mile away. Sports facilities in the area include football, rugby and cricket clubs along with water activities being offered on the river. Melksham also has great provision for other clubs including dance, gymnastics and martial arts. Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Rainbows, Brownies and Guides also have groups









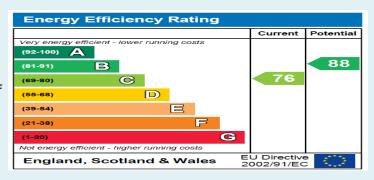
