



2 Cottage By The Mill, West Ashling

With a direct view over the mill pond in the delightful Downland village of West Ashling, this semi-detached period cottage has its own woodland extending to just over a third of an acre.

The charming project is Grade II listed and offers a fabulous opportunity to purchase a character home in a much sought after location on the southern periphery of the South Downs National Park about five miles east of the cathedral city of Chichester.

The accommodation includes a sitting room overlooking the mill pond, kitchen, two bedrooms and a bathroom.

Outside, the woodland extends to the side and rear of the property and has a stream flowing through the middle feeding into the mill pond opposite. There is vehicular access off Watery Lane behind the property to a gravel driveway and two garages.



West Ashling is located about five miles north west of Chichester and has a local village pub, primary school and a picturesque mill pond. The area is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the South Downs and around Chichester Harbour. Local amenities can be found in nearby Funtington and Bosham. The cathedral city of Chichester offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars, the Festival Theatre and a mainline station to London Victoria. Goodwood is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival.

Directions

Proceed out of Chichester on the B2178 (Funtington Road). After passing through East Ashling take the turning on the left into Southbrook Road signposted to West Ashling. On entering West Ashling, turn right into Down Street which leads into Mill Road and the property is adjacent to the Mill Pond.
