Threshers is on the Western edge of Crediton and is just a couple of minutes walk from countryside walks and handy for all the amenities Crediton has to offer. Windfall is a 1940s solid built semi detached house set back from the road and offers a wonderful slice of living in this thriving market town.











The main door to the side of the property leads into this well maintained and well presented home, there is a lounge/diner spreading across the whole front of the house, the family kitchen has views of the rear garden and there's also a handy downstairs wet room with WC. There's a modern single story extension to the rear full of light from the triple bi-fold doors leading to a decked area outside on the edge of the garden. The wide stairs from the hall lead up to 3 bedrooms and a bathroom, all three bedrooms have generous built-in storage and there's well placed radiators throughout the property along with uPVC double glazing.

Outside offers well maintained gardens laid to lawn and flower boarders to the front and back. There are two garden shed in the rear garden and a large garage/store on the front drive. The driveway will easily accommodate 3 cars.








Ground Floor
