A charming four bedroom detached family house situated in the heart of Tangmere village, about five miles east of Chichester. The property was built in 1996 by respected local builders Seaward Homes and is one of just three properties which form Hunters Gate.

The well-proportioned accommodation includes a dual aspect L-shaped open plan sitting/dining room with doors leading out to the rear garden, a kitchen which leads to a utility room and in turn a cloakroom. On the first floor, all four bedrooms have fitted wardrobes/cupboards and the principal bedroom enjoys an en-suite shower room/WC. A bathroom/WC can also be found on the first floor.

Outside, to the front of the property is a driveway which leads to a detached double garage. A patio area adjoins the rear of the property which gives way to lawn in the enclosed rear garden.

Location

Tangmere has a Co-op convenience store, village hall, medical centre, primary school and church. Three miles to the west lies the cathedral city of Chichester which offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars, the Festival Theatre and a mainline station to London Victoria. Nearby Goodwood is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival. There are superb sailing facilities around Chichester Harbour and water sports from the beaches at West Wittering. The area is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the South Downs and around the harbour.
