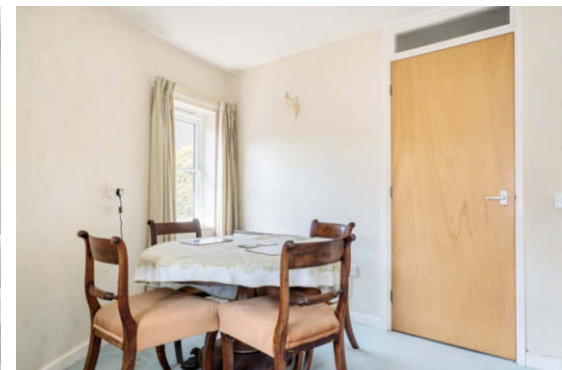
Rose Court has a resident manager and out of hours 'Careline' so twenty-four hours emergency assistance is available. All rooms have emergency pull cords. On the same floor there is a communal laundry. Parking is available on a first come first served basis, in a car barn at the rear of the building.

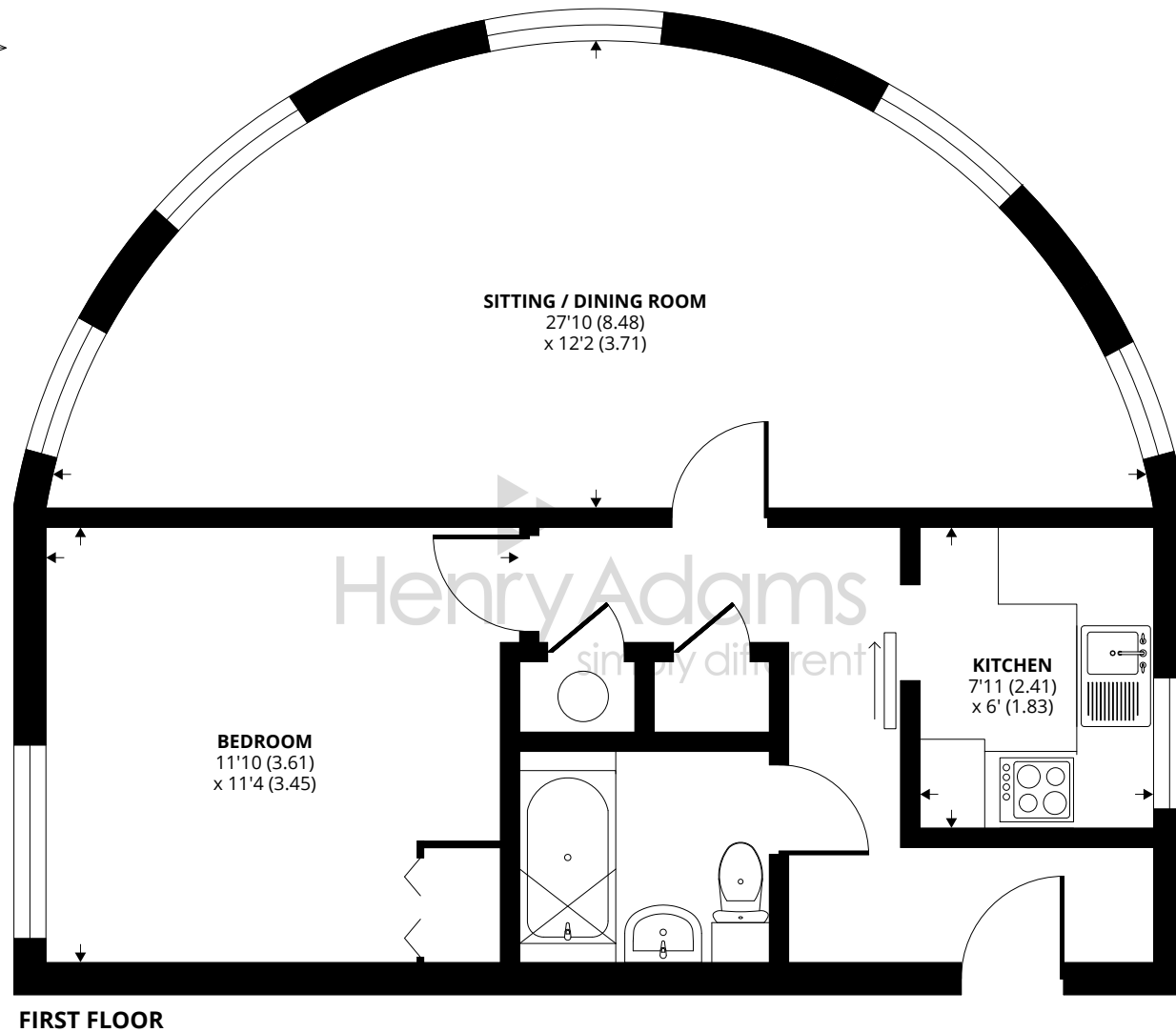
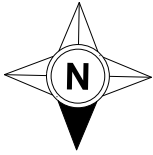

Location

Located in a central position within the city walls and within easy access of the pedestrian shopping precinct. The cathedral city of Chichester offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars, the Festival Theatre and a mainline station to London Victoria. Close by there is the library and regular bus service (outside the cathedral) to Tesco and Sainsburys. Goodwood is located to the north and is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival.

Directions

Proceed on foot from the city centre cross into West Street with the cathedral on the left, turn right into Chapel Street. Follow the road north and Rose Court will be seen on the right hand side. There is a pay and display car park adjacent or covered visitors parking at the rear of the building.
