





An iconic property in the heart of Harleston which has been owned by the same family for over 50 years

Mill House is an imposing early 19th Century Grade II Listed house with impressive leaded light bay windows to the front that were a later addition. It is an iconic and prominent house in the centre of the highly sought-after market town of Harleston with an abundance of charm and character. The property has been owned by the same family for more than 50 years and has been totally unspoilt by time offering an incoming purchaser enormous potential to update and personalise the house. The vendors went to great lengths to maintain the integrity and warmth of the property.

The accommodation is both spacious and versatile and there is a substantial second floor which offers further potential subject to planning permission and Listed Building Consent.

In addition to the house is an outstanding range of period outbuildings to the rear around a courtyard. The vendors ran a successful pottery business from the outbuildings including one being used as a shop and this is still in use today. Whilst the outbuildings have

been used for commercial purposes the vendor does have consent for change of use to residential under reference 2022/1150. This offers huge potential subject to further planning permission. To the right of the drive is a delightful walled garden which is a superb feature for a house at the heart of the town.

LOCATION

Harleston is a thriving market town with many historical buildings and an excellent range of independently owned shops along with a supermarket, doctors, veterinary surgery, schools to G.C.S.E. level, 2 hotels, a number of cafes, restaurants and pubs. There is a strong sense of community with many events going on all year and lots of local clubs, organisations and activities.





