This 1950's semi-detached house is found in a level position, on the Western edge of Crediton, close to primary and secondary schools, bus transport links to Exeter and many beautiful countryside walks.

The well-presented accommodation includes three good useable bedrooms, with the master bedroom enjoying a lovely view over gardens onto rolling Devon countryside beyond, served by an upstairs white-suite bathroom with shower attachment and screen over the bath.











The ground floor includes the living room, a large kitchen diner complete with pantry, a door leads to a side boot room with separate entrance and has a downstairs WC and utility area. The kitchen includes a Britania range style cooker, marble effect solid laminate worktops and shaker style units, the flooring is porcelain wood effect tiles. There is mains gas central heating via a modern Worcester Boiler, uPVC windows, facias and soffits.

Outside: To the front is parking for 3-4 cars within a gated area. The main lawned garden (12m x 11m) is to the side and is South-West facing, there is also a rear paved courtyard (8.3m x 7.7m max (being a triangular shape), ideal for summer barbecues, there is also a front herb garden.

There is ample space to the side to extend the living accommodation further if desired (subject to permissions).
