

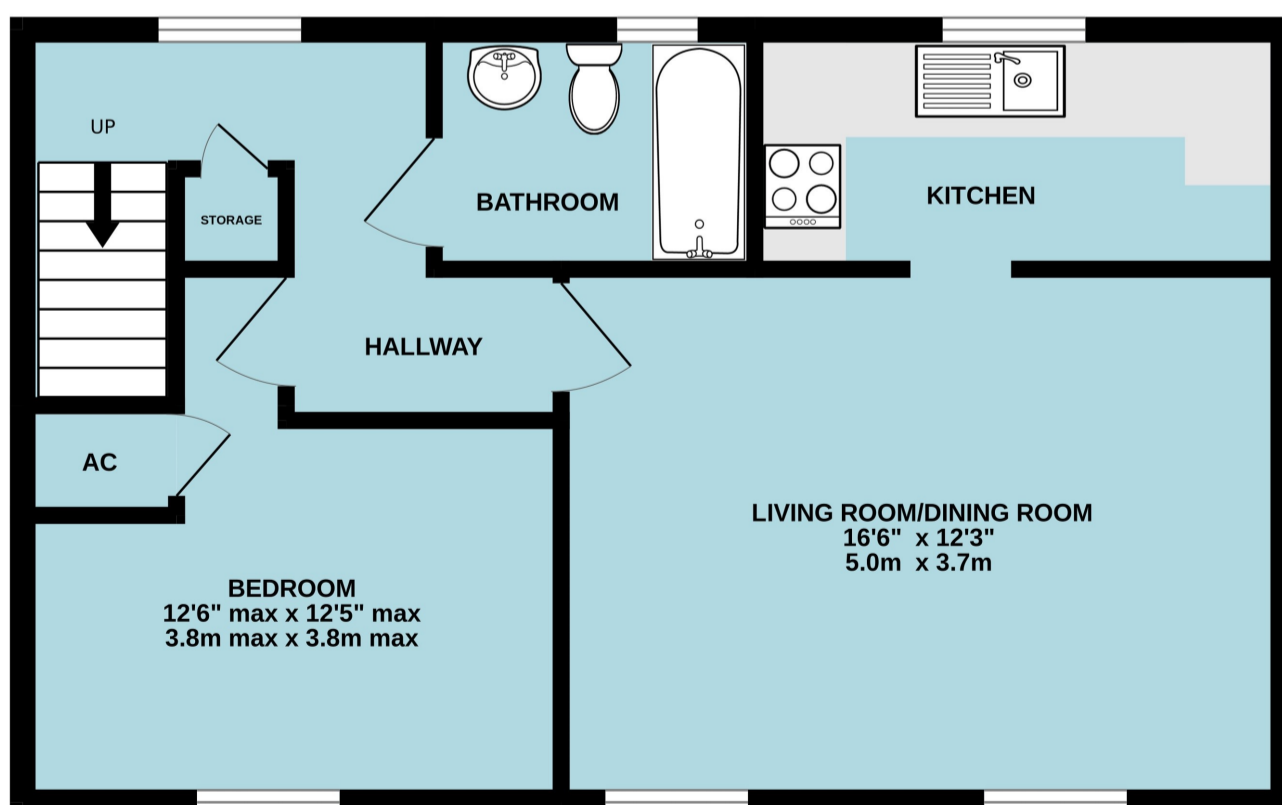

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Description

This one bedroom coach house is offered to the market freehold and benefits from off-road parking and a spacious garage. The property is served by gas fired central heating.

THE PROPERTY:

There is a door through to the hall leading to stairs to the first floor where there is a living room/dining room over 16' in length. The separate kitchen has a range of high and low level units, built-in oven, hob and an extractor hood together with a sink and double glazed window. The principal bedroom has a built-in airing cupboard and storage together with loft access. This is complemented by a main bathroom with bath, shower over, tiled surround, vanity basin, WC and double glazed window.

Outside - The driveway leads to the garage - which has an additional storage recess - and plumbing for a washing machine and space for a tumble dryer with light and power connected.

LOCATION: The property is situated on the north-west side of the market town of Bridgwater. The town offers a range of amenities including retail, educational and leisure facilities. The M5 junctions 23 and 24 are nearby, together with main line links via Bridgwater Railway station. There are regular bus services to Taunton, Weston-super-Mare and Burnham-on-Sea together with a daily coach service to London Hammersmith.
