








Description

Offered to the market with vacant possession, is this 2/3 bedroom, semidetached family home situated in a peaceful cul-de-sac position.

The property is warmed via a gas fired central heating system and is uPVC double glazed. There is a South facing rear garden along with a single garage and a driveway providing off-road parking.

The property is warmed via a gas fired central heating system, is uPVC double glazed and offers accommodation which is arranged over two floors. The accommodation comprises in brief; entrance hallway with stairs rising to the first floor, kitchen fitted with a range of matching wall and base storage units with roll edge work surfaces above, space for an electric cooker, space and plumbing for a washing machine and space for a fridge/freezer.

The ground floor accommodation is completed with a good size living room/dining room with windows to both the front and rear. On the first floor there is a bathroom with separate WC, a master bedroom with aspect to the rear and a further bedroom which has been split into two rooms by the current owner. Externally, there is a South facing rear garden which is laid to lawn, patio and decking. There is a good size pond, a metal shed and single garage with an up-and-over door. In front of the garage there is a driveway providing off road parking for one car.
