An extended three bedroom detached house, situated in a popular non estate location on the south side of the city about half a mile walk from the shopping centre.

The accommodation includes a formal sitting room at the front and an open plan kitchen/family room extension incorporating the original dining room at the rear. This is a spacious 'L' shaped room with French doors opening to the south facing rear garden from the family room area. There is also bathroom on the ground floor. A door from the kitchen opens to a long workshop/store widening at one end into garage suitable for a small car (*Ford KA or similar). Upstairs there are three bedrooms and a second bathroom.

Outside, there is a courtyard style front garden enveloped by a mature hedge with an attractive tiled path and a block paved drive. The south east rear garden is attractively landscaped with a central lawn, patio and mature borders.
