UPVC double-glazed window to front, plastered emulsion décor, patterned artex ceiling, laminate flooring, two radiators, ample electric power points, gas service meters housed within recess storage, open-plan stairs to first floor elevation with fitted carpet and spindled balustrade, double patterned glaze panel doors to rear allowing access to kitchen.

UPVC double-glazed window to front, plastered emulsion décor with one feature wall papered, fitted carpet, radiator, range of built-in wardrobes providing ample hanging and shelving space, patterned artex ceiling.

UPVC double-glazed window to rear, plastered emulsion décor with one wall papered, fitted carpet, radiator, range of built-in wardrobes, patterned artex ceiling, electric power points.
