With open brick built fireplace, down lighters, cupboard housing fuses and electric meter, wall thermostat, window to front

Radiator, stairs to first floor with under stairs storage area, down lighters, opening to Kitchen

Fitted with a range of eye and base level units incorporating sink unit with mixer tap and drainer, built in Hotpoint oven, fitted four ring Neff hob with extractor over, space for fridge/freezer, space and plumbing for slimline dishwasher, space and plumbing for washing machine, radiator, part tiled walls, window to rear, door to garden, velux window to rear

White suite comprising panelled bath with mixer tap and shower attachment, low level W.C., wash hand basin with mixer tap, part tiled walls, down lighters, window to rear


Parking

An paved patio leads to the remainder of garden which is laid to lawn. There is a timber shed and all is enclosed by panelled fencing. The garden enjoys a sunny westerly aspect and extends to 61'.
