

21 NORTH STREET, WAREHAM £350,000 Freehold This is a rare opportunity to acquire substantial freehold office/retail premises situated at the northern end of the main shopping thoroughfare of the town. It is within the Wareham Conservation Area, close to St. Martin's Church and the Saxon Walls, with parking and customer facilities nearby.

CONSTRUCTION

The building is part of a terrace and is constructed of brick under a pitched roof covered with tiles.

LOCATION

The market town of Wareham lies at the heart of countryside designated as National Landscapes and is often described as the "Gateway to the Isle of Purbeck". The town is pleasantly situated between the Rivers Piddle and Frome and has a wide range of shops and small shops, restaurants, public houses, library, churches and the Rex cinema.

TRANSPORT COMMUNICATIONS

Mainline rail link at Wareham, to London Waterloo approximately 2.5 hours. The A31 can be joined at Bere Regis providing a route to the M27/M3 and London/Home Counties beyond.

PLANNING

A pre-planning application has been submitted to Dorset Council as part of a larger scheme incorporating no: 19 North Street to convert the upper floors into residential apartments. If this application is favourably considered it is possible the upper floor of no: 21 could be used for residential purposes without combining it with the next door property.
