Location

Bury St Edmunds is located on the A14 dual carriageway, which provides access to Felixstowe, home of the UK's largest container port, and west to key road infrastructure such as the M11, A11, A1(M), M1 and M6.

This network provides access to many of the UK's major cities including London and the South East, Cambridge, Birmingham, Manchester, Liverpool and Leeds.


