


MONTPELIER SQUARE

Situated in the sought-after Knightsbridge neighbourhood, Montpelier Square features a row of elegant Georgian townhouses built between 1825 and 1850.





This Grade II listed family home, constructed of traditional brick with a white stucco front, spans over the lower ground and four upper floors. Now on the market, having been owned by the same family for 50 years. Positioned in the southfacing quiet corner of the square, with a current internal floor area of 2,923 sq ft and potential to extend, subject to relevant consents, and has the added benefit of access and views over the award-winning garden square.

Nearby, residents can enjoy the green expanse of Hyde Park, along with Harrods, Harvey Nichols and all the other internationally renowned hotels, restaurants, shops, museums, schools, and universities close by. Heathrow airport is conveniently just 14 miles away.




LOWER GROUND FLOOR










SECOND FLOOR
