

Situated local to schools, Croyland park and other amenities is this vacant three bedroom semi detached property which benefits from uPVC double glazing, gas radiator central heating, built in kitchen appliances and newly fitted carpets. The property further offers separate reception rooms, a conservatory, a utility room, reception rooms, a conservatory, ensuite shower room to the master bedroom and a garage. The accommodation briefly comprises porch, entrance hall, lounge, dining room, conservatory, kitchen, utility room, cloakroom, master bedroom with ensuite shower room, two further bedrooms, bathroom, gardens to front and rear and a garage.
