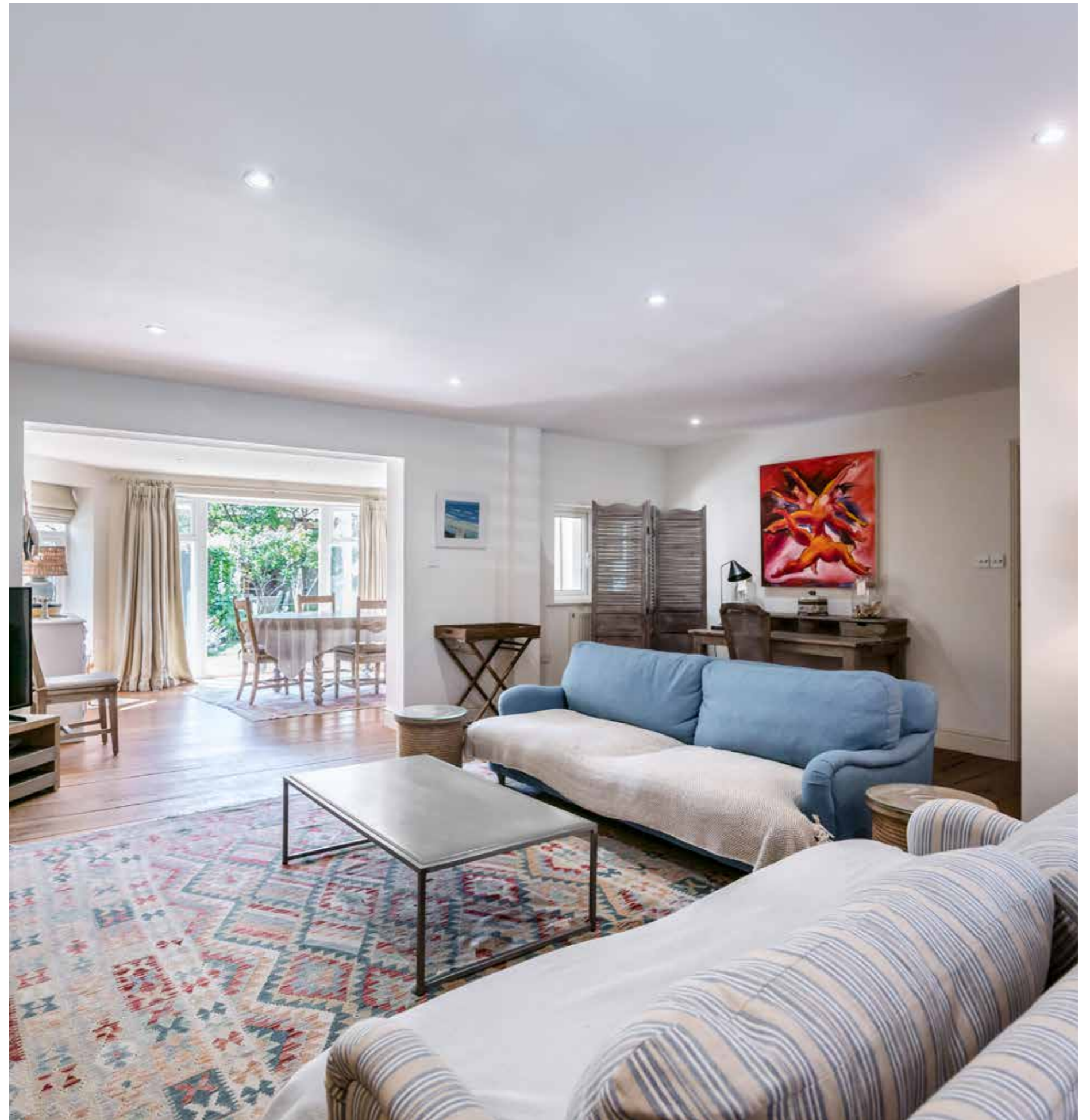

Upstairs there are three bedrooms, two large doubles and a single and these share the family bathroom also upstairs and there is a second WC on the ground floor.

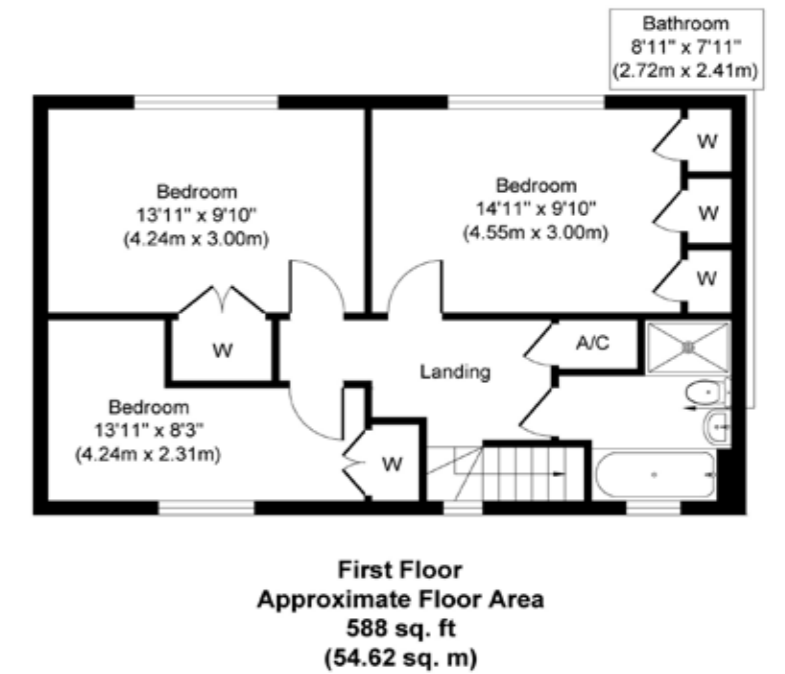
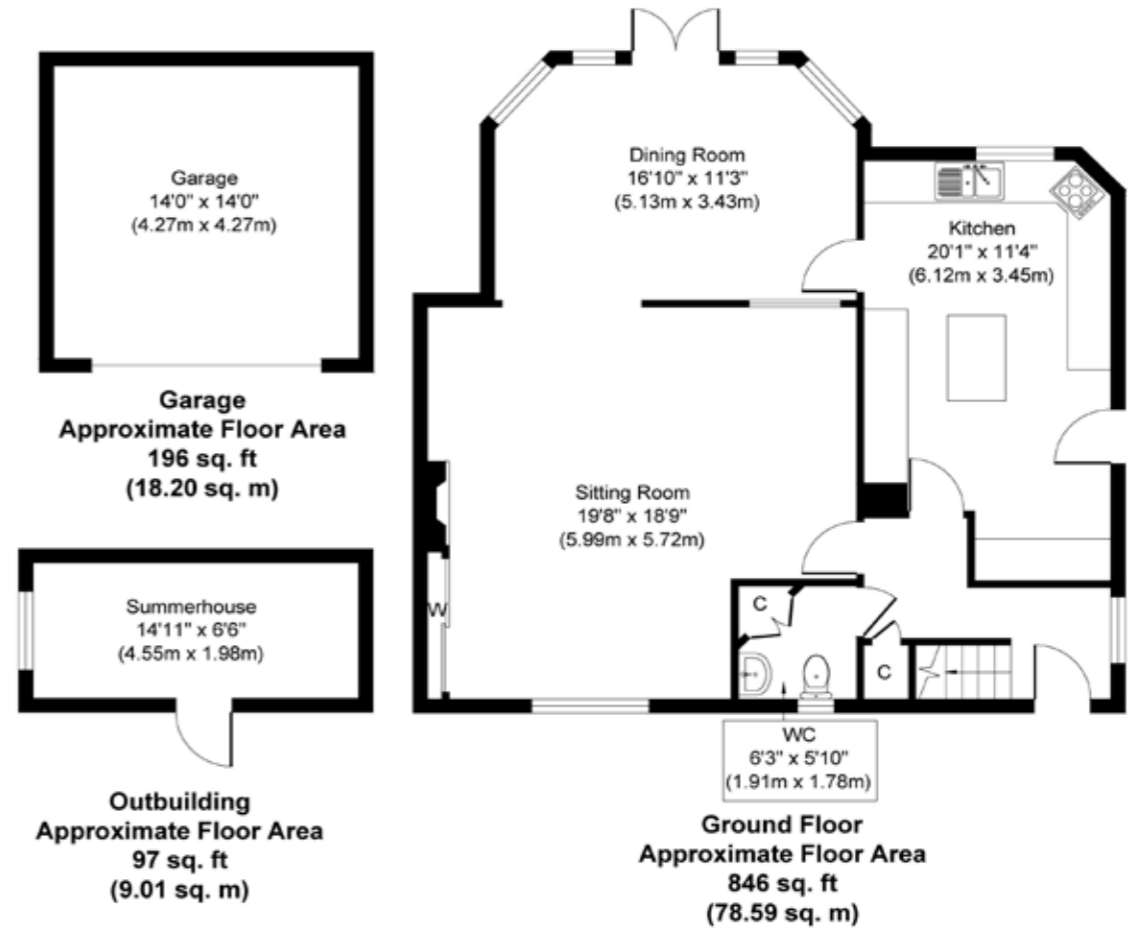
