the details...

Access is through a door with glazed panel into the entrance porch, ideal for coats, shoes and boots. A half-glazed door leads into the sitting room which is full of character with an attractive fireplace housing a wood burning stove, ideal for those chilly days after a country walk. To one side of the chimney are display shelves and the other side a unit with a remote control shelf, which lowers the T.V into a cupboard when not in use. Multi paned window to the front and a picture rail. A further half glazed multi paned door leads into the kitchen/breakfast room with a window to the rear of the property and a half-glazed door leading out into the garden. The kitchen is fitted with a range of floor cupboards with work tops over incorporating a sink, an oven with hob over, solid fuel Rayburn which serves the hot water, radiators on the first floor and cooking. Spaces for washing machine and upright fridge/freezer. A attractive wall mounted display shelf unit and shelving provide additional storage, tiled floor, stairs rising to first floor.

On the first floor is a large double bedroom with a multipane window to the front, radiator and an attractive period style fireplace. The second bedroom is a small single with a window to the rear, heated towel rail and again a period style fireplace. Completing the accommodation is the shower room fitted with a corner shower cubicle, pedestal hand basin and w.c.
