A two double bedroom end of terrace house in a highly sought after position close to the Festival Theatre and the city centre. King George Gardens is a private estate built by Croudace Homes in the grounds of the former Royal West Sussex Hospital, and is well maintained to a high standard.

Enjoying a position at the far end of a cul-de-sac, the property benefits from gas central heating and double glazed windows. The accommodation consists of a cloakroom, kitchen and sitting room with a conservatory leading off which overlooks the rear garden. On the first floor, there are two double bedrooms one of which benefits from an en-suite shower room/WC. A bathroom/WC can also be found on this floor.

Outside, to the front of the property is a driveway which provides off-road parking and leads to an attached garage with personal door leading to the rear garden. The rear garden enjoys a southerly aspect and is paved for low maintenance.

Short walk to the Festival Theatre and onto the city centre of the cathedral city of Chichester. There is excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars and a mainline station to London Victoria. Goodwood to the north is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival. There are superb sailing facilities around Chichester Harbour and water sports from the beaches at West Wittering. The area is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the South Downs and around the harbour.
