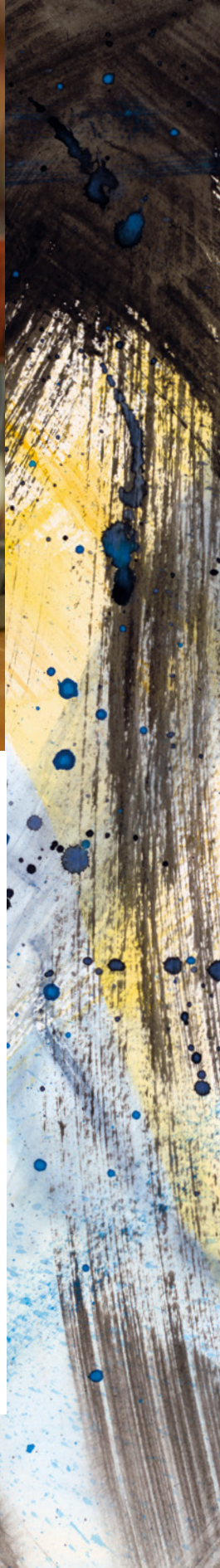

The iconic Battersea Power Station is now a major shopping and dining destination and includes London's first art'otel as well as a boutique cinema and the Turbine theatre. With spaces dedicated to arts and culture including galleries, pop-up exhibitions, and public art

installations, the Power Station is reflective of the wider arts scene. Elsewhere you'll find the Battersea Arts Centre, which has been home to world-class theatre performances for over 50 years, and other community favourites such as the Grade II restored Pump House Gallery, and the Olivier award-winning Theatre503, known for its commitment to new writing and emerging talent.
