The properties have double glazing and are heated by a ground source heat pump system. All communal maintenance, running costs and upkeep, such as window cleaning, gardening and lift maintenance is included in the bi-annual management charge.

The fully furnished owners' lounge features Wi-Fi access and a coffee bar which provides a relaxed communal meeting place for residents and their guests. There is also a fully furnished guest suite. Safety and security is provided via a secure video entry system, an intruder alarm system and a 24 hour Careline support system operated via a digital call system.


Situation

Yeats Lodge is situated in the market town of Thame which is a popular market town situated on the Oxon/Bucks borders. There are many independent shops, delicatessens, and a Waitrose. Thame is steeped in history, with beautiful buildings, some dating back to Tudor times, a medieval church, and a local museum. On the gastronomic side it has award winning bars and restaurants. There is also an annual food festival, art and literature festivals, various music, and comedy festivals. Thame also has a health centre, cottage hospital, various societies, and sports club such as the Chinnor rugby club, the tennis club, bowls club and U3A. Transport wise, London Marylebone can be reached in 34 minutes via nearby Haddenham & Thame Parkway Station. Also, M40, junction 7 for access to London, Birmingham and the North is approximately 10 minutes' drive away. There are also regular bus services to Oxford, Aylesbury, and the neighbouring villages, which have walks, country pubs and beautiful scenery.

















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
