This three bedroom semi-detached home is offered to the market providing a perfect opportunity for someone to really make it their own.

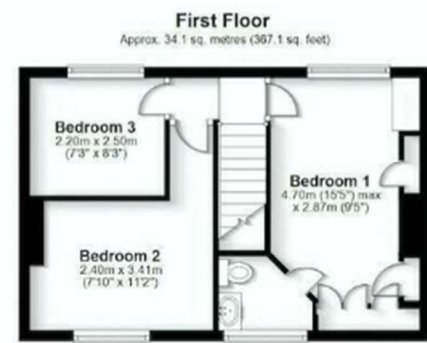

Rickmansworth has plenty of countryside nearby for walks and cycling but is also close enough to London to offer residents the chance of the hustle and bustle of the big city. One of Rickmansworth's most popular destinations is the 41 hectares of Local Nature Reserve the Aquadrome, with Lakes, woodland, children's play area and the popular Café in the Park.
