

A selection of formal and flexible reception rooms caters perfectly to the ever-changing demands of modern family life. At the heart of the home lies a sociable kitchen with a breakfast bar, offering a wealth of fine cabinetry and serving as a natural hub, flanked by a snug and large garden room.

The first floor accommodates no fewer than five spacious bedrooms, including two with en-suites. The generous principal suite features a walk-in wardrobe in addition to its en-suite, while another en-suite bedroom is complemented by three further double bedrooms, all well-served by the central family bathroom.


The village falls within the catchment area for the well-regarded Reepham High School, with a nearby primary school catering to younger children.
