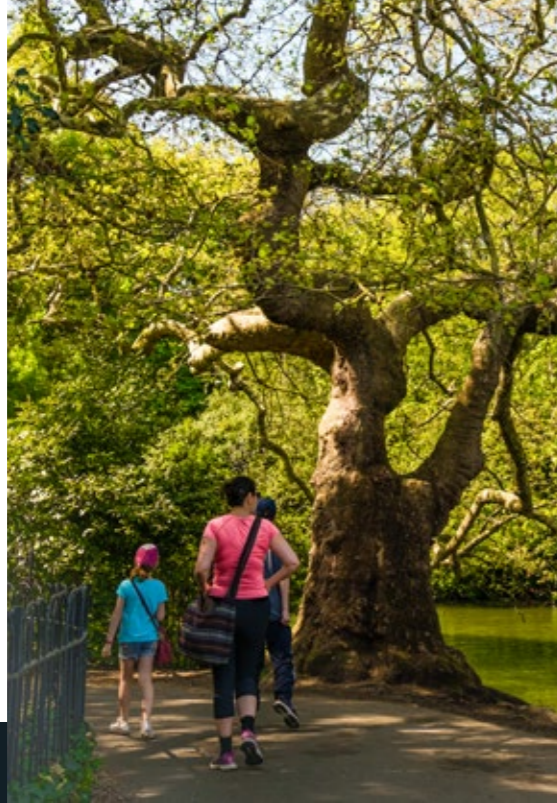

Louis de Bernières lived in Earlsfield while writing his most famous novel – and it's easy to see why he speaks of the area with such fondness.

This vibrant, culturally switched-on community is a destination for creatives, culture-lovers and fans of stage and screen. Take the uniquely brilliant Backyard Cinema, with its pop-up Winter Night Garden, Miami Beach and LA Nights experiences, or the pioneering Tara Theatre (now a Theatre of Sanctuary for its work helping to support refugee communities and amplifying the voices of asylum seekers), which nurtures Asian talent and hosts its own shows as well as local and national touring productions.

Up in Wandsworth, a 14-screen branch of Cineworld also puts blockbuster movies within walking distance – with plenty of pre- and post-film entertainment close on hand.

Connectivity

Like most modern developments in the area, **The Garratt Collection is car-free by design and incorporates cycle storage for every home.**

Earlsfield train station is just 11 minutes' walk South, getting you into London Waterloo in under quarter of an hour, with the Southfields tube stop just 21 minutes' walk east. Three bus routes run adjacent and Heathrow airport lies just 12 miles west – so however far your next trip takes you, you're never short of ways to get there.

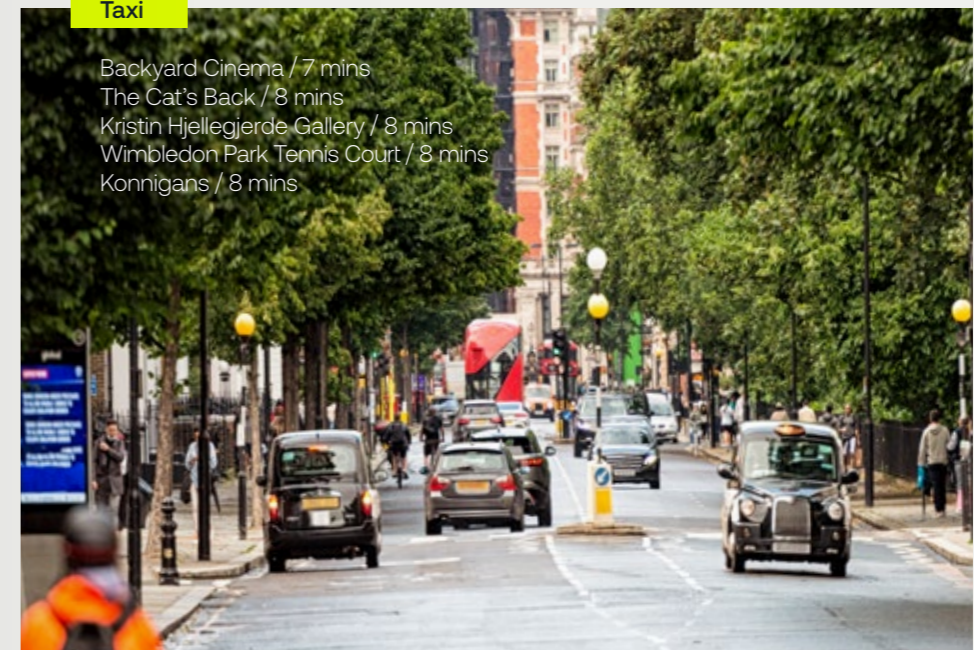

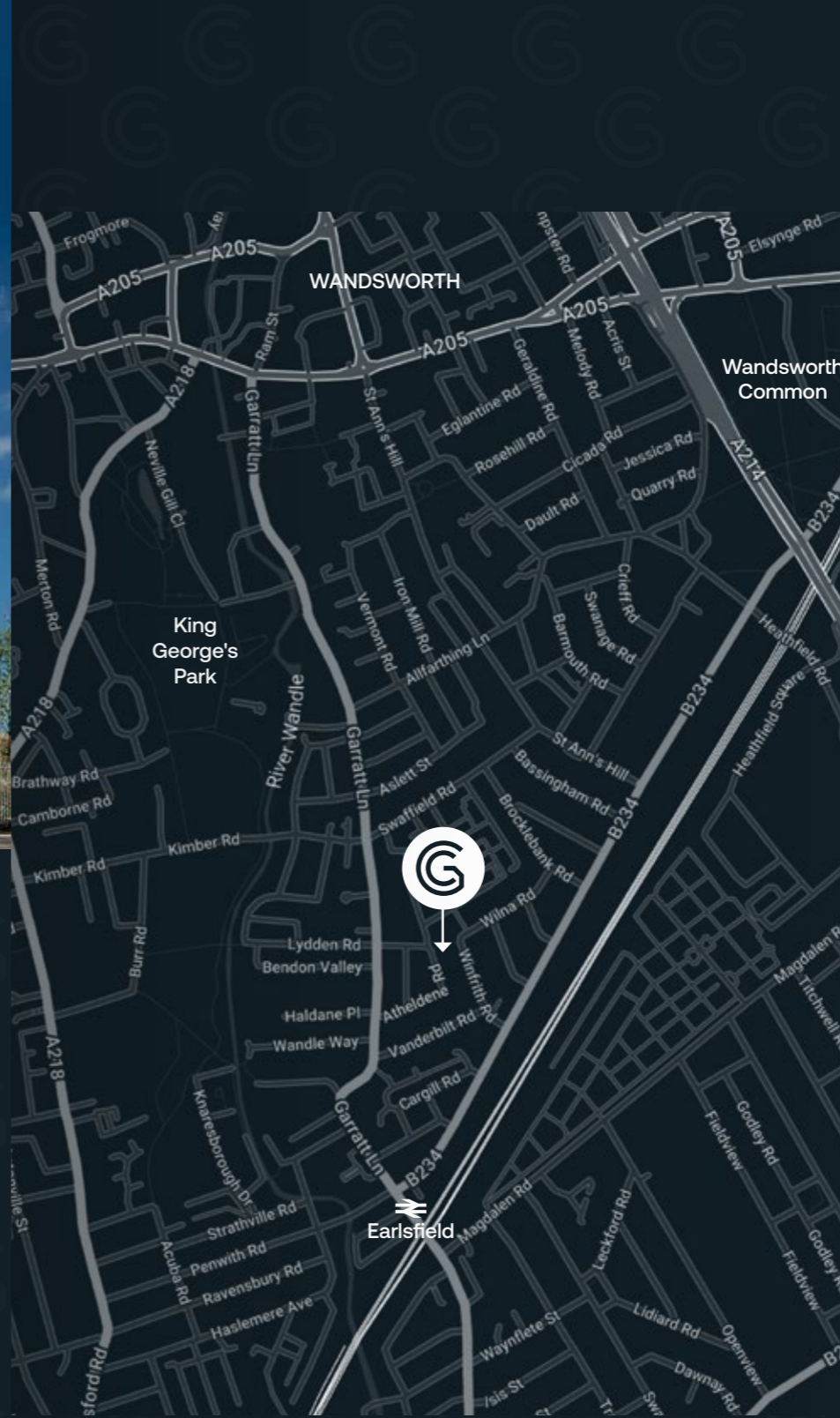
