A doors leads to a spacious utility room which has a second sink, work tops, with windows and a door to the garden. A separate living room has bay windows with a front aspect. Upstairs are four double sized bedrooms with bedroom one enjoying the use of a walk-in wardrobe and an ensuite shower room. The sumptuous family bathroom has been recently modernised and provides a freestanding bath, separate shower cubicle, double basin and a w/c. The rear garden has wooden decking for summer dining, a lawn with a shed to the rear.

Location

Berkhamsted is a busy market town, located to the West of Hertfordshire and just 30 minutes from London by train with the mainline train station providing a regular service into London Euston. Major road connections nearby include the M25 (J20) and the M1 (J8 and J9). The A41 dual carriageway runs to the South of the town, providing an excellent connection to Hemel Hempstead, Watford, Tring and Aylesbury.

The area offers excellent schooling, including Berkhamsted School, founded in 1541, and Tring Park School for the Performing Arts.










