This property is presented to a good standard and offers light and spacious accommodation over two floors with hard floors throughout the downstairs. The property impresses from entering with a spacious entrance hall leading through the property with a sitting room to the left-hand side. This sitting room has hard floors and a feature bay window to the front of the property. On the right-hand side is a further room to be used as a bedroom or further reception to suit the purchaser. There is a further bedroom and then family bathroom opposite again presented to a good standard. There is a further dining room at the back of the property along with the well presented kitchen. These two rooms could be opened up to create a open plan kitchen/breakfast room if required. Upstairs the property impresses further offering a principle bedroom and ensuite presented to a good standard and with plenty of light.


