

A charming market town, only 5 minutes from the park. Packed with independent shops and cafés, Pocklington is exactly what you would expect from a Yorkshire village surrounded by stunning countryside.

Take a stroll along the medieval Pocklington Canal, keeping an eye out for a whole host of local wildlife.

passing of the seasons


Yorkshire Air Museum

Site Fees & Maintenance Fees

Site fees - £4,054.93*

Annual Maintenance fee - £761.25*

Your site fees help us ensure Allerthorpe stays in tip top condition, keeping the park maintained to a high standard as well as cutting your grass, street lighting, security barrier maintenance and refuse disposal. Site fees also give you the right to site your holiday home on a base within our park. All holiday parks charge site fees, and we do everything we can to ensure yours stay as affordable as possible.

Annual Rates

Because your holiday home won't be your primary residence, you won't be required to pay council tax. Instead you'll pay an annual rates charge of £205*.

Gas, Electric & Water

Gas, electricity and water are paid directly by you, and will vary based on your consumption and how much you use in your holiday home. Utilities billed quarterly.

Insurance

Like most things, you'll need insurance for your holiday home. Our team can help you with getting the right cover, however your policy and ensuring it's renewed each year is your responsibility. We will also need to be provided with an updated copy of your insurance annually.
