a direct route the motorway network, Gatwick airport is just over 14 miles to the north and the cosmopolitan city of Brighton and the coast is a similar distance to the south.

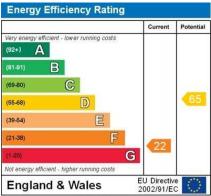

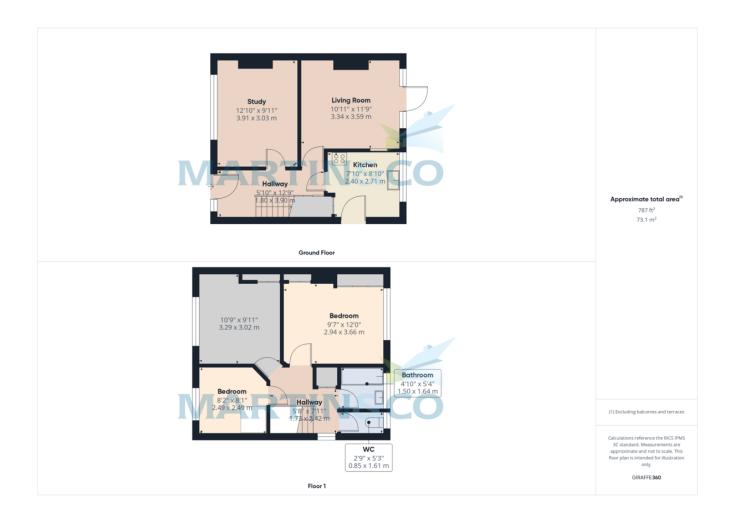
