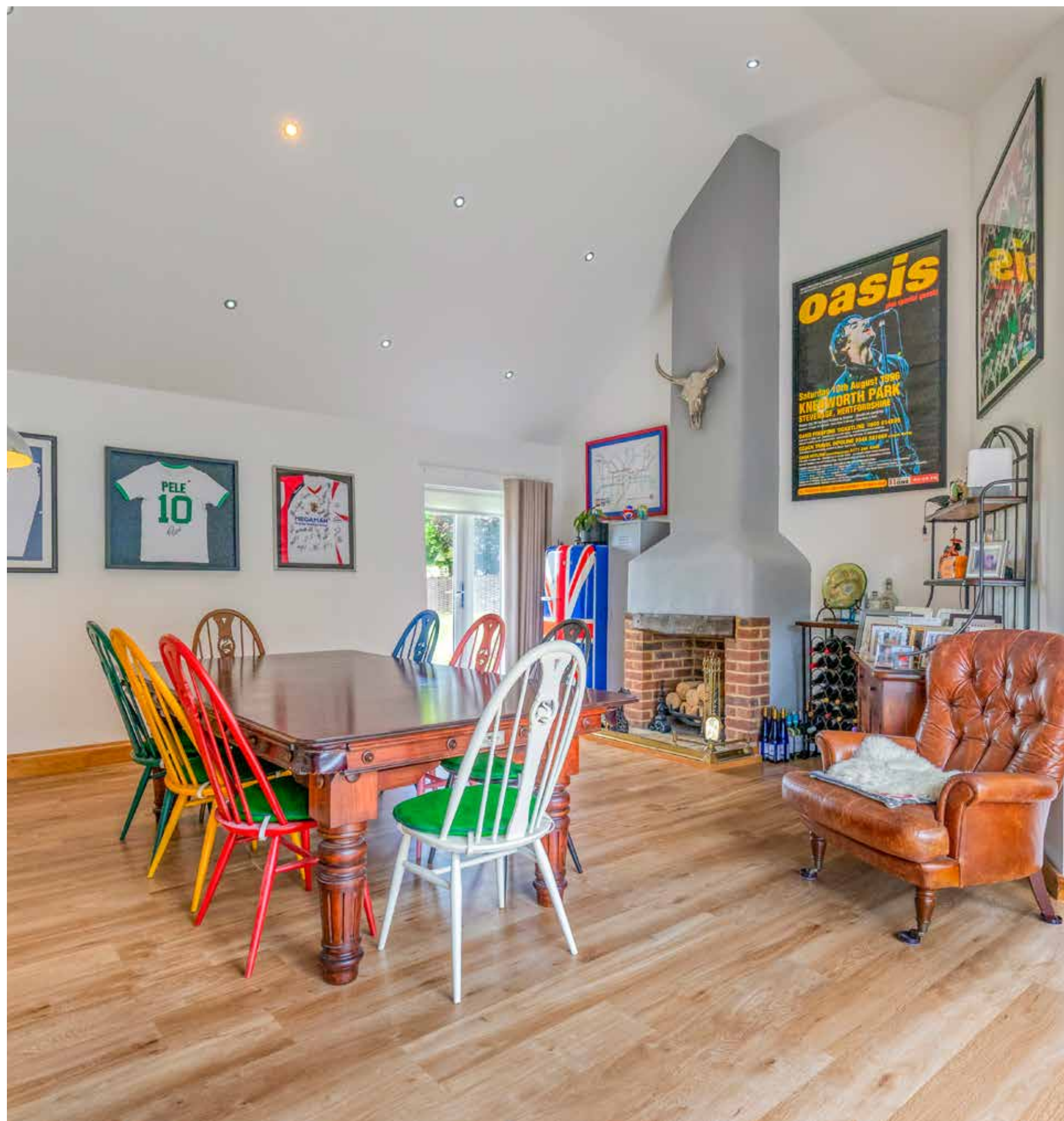

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Tucked away in the heart of the Norfolk countryside, White Swan Barn is a truly special home, steeped in rustic character yet meticulously modernised throughout. Once an old cowshed, this exceptional single-storey barn conversion now offers over 2,260 sq. ft. of light-filled, flexible living space, all set within a tranquil village near the river and surrounded by open farmland.

Since moving in, the current owners have lovingly enhanced the property, bringing elegance and functionality together through a series of considered upgrades. The pièce de résistance? A stunning collection of bespoke windows and doors, crafted to elevate both natural light and energy efficiency, while perfectly complementing the barn's heritage stone exterior.

Step inside and you're welcomed by a generous reception hall, flowing into a vast open-plan kitchen/dining room, the true heart of the home. Bathed in daylight and anchored by a central island, this space is perfect for entertaining or simply soaking in the peaceful views beyond. Adjacent lies the expansive drawing room, a space of warmth and calm, ideal for evenings in.

To one side, the accommodation wing hosts three beautifully proportioned double bedrooms. The principal suite boasts an en-suite shower room and garden views, while the further two bedrooms are served by a stylish family bathroom. The second reception room, currently arranged as a formal dining area, offers yet more versatility, with french doors opening onto a highly private courtyard garden, where a raised terrace provides the perfect spot for al fresco dining or sun-drenched morning coffees.



The overall feel of light in the house is amazing, especially in the kitchen.





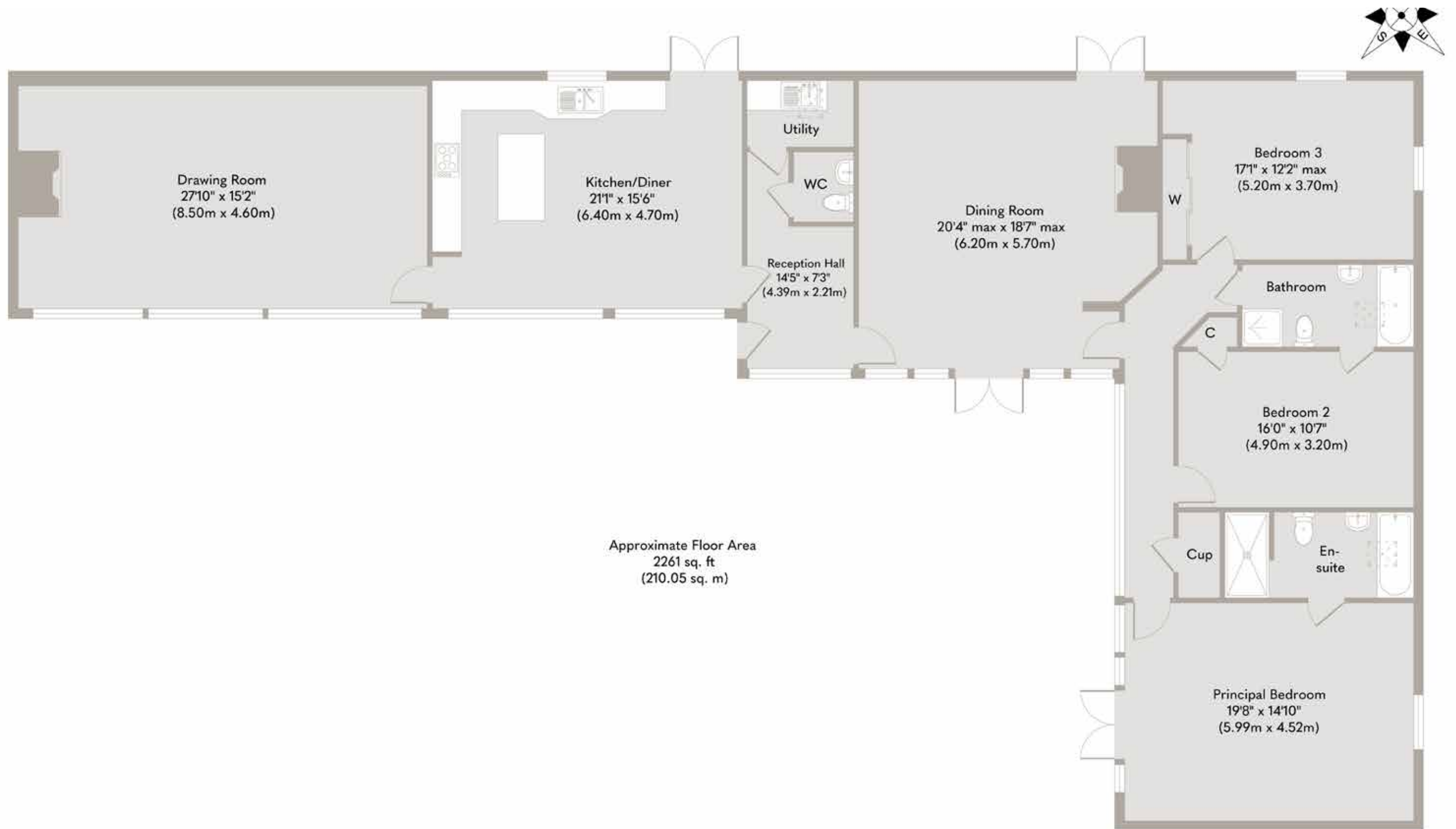
Beyond the interiors, the sense of serenity continues. The barn is framed by immaculately maintained gardens, a private gated entrance, and a large south-facing lawn. Nature lovers will delight in the surroundings: just 100 yards from the house, a secluded stretch of river teems with wildlife—deer, otters, birdlife, and even the occasional seal.

Situated in the heart of the Breckland district of Norfolk, Hockwold is a picturesque village that blends rural charm with rich historical character. Situated near the borders of Suffolk and Cambridgeshire, it offers a tranquil setting surrounded by open farmland, ancient woodland, and the unique sandy heathland that defines the Brecks.
