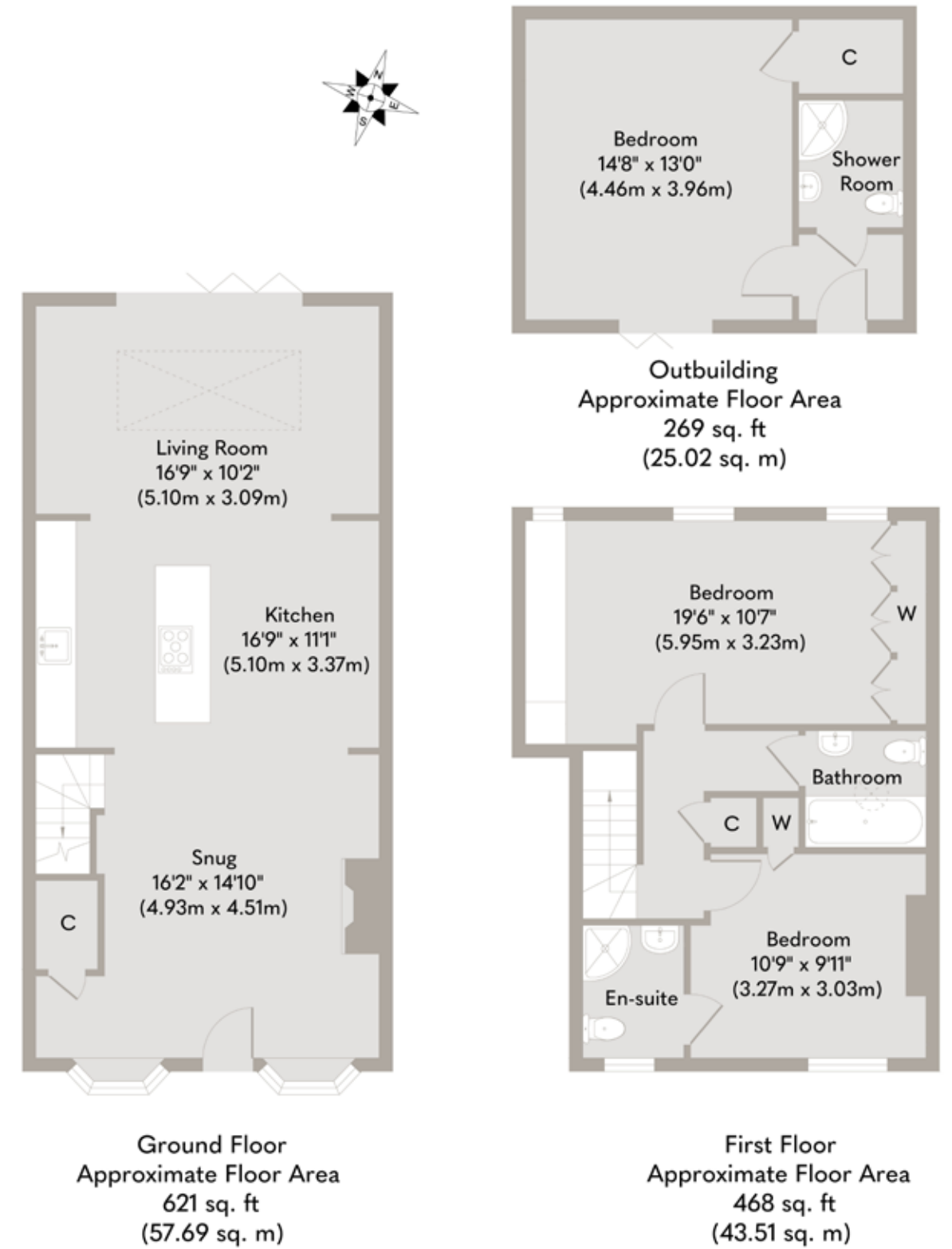
Stepping through the charming Victorian shopfront windows, you enter a stunning open-plan living space that flows effortlessly from front to rear. At its heart, a beautifully crafted handmade kitchen sits opposite a spacious dining area, making it a perfect spot for entertaining. To the front, the inviting lounge is centred around a sleek inset fireplace, creating a cosy atmosphere for winter evenings. To the rear, full-width bi-fold doors open onto the garden, blurring the lines between inside and out. This sense of light and space is further enhanced by an elegant ceiling lantern, which floods the area with natural light throughout the day.

Upstairs, what were once three small bedrooms has been transformed into two spacious doubles. The principal bedroom stretches across the entire width of the house, offering a wonderful sense of openness and a bathroom conveniently located next door.
